July 1, 1970

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Changes During June

Cold storage stocks increased during June for butter, cheese, frozen eggs, chicken, turkeys, strawberries and green peas. Commodities with decreases in stocks during June include apples, most frozen fruits, most frozen vegetables and nearly all meat items.

Butter stocks increased 41 million pounds during June, cheese 33 million, frozen eggs 7 million, chicken 6 million, turkeys 18 million, strawberries 95 million and green peas 58 million pounds.

Decreases in stocks during June include 144 million pounds in apples, 87 million in frozen french fried potatoes, 40 million in total beef and 53 million pounds in total pork.

Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space on July 1 totaled 1,369 million pounds, down 162 million from June 1 but 35 million pounds above a year earlier.

Stocks in freezer space totaled 4,547 million pounds on July 1, up 55 million from a month earlier and 436 million pounds above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 59 percent occupied on July 1, the same as a month earlier but 2 points below a year earlier. Gains in cooler occupancy during June in the East North Central, West North Central, and Mountain Regions were offset by declines in the Middle Atlantic and Pacific Regions. Other regions were unchanged.

Freezer space was 68 percent occupied on July 1, unchanged from June 1 but 4 points above a year earlier. Freezer occupancy increased during June in all regions except the Middle Atlantic and Mountain where there were declines, and the East South Central and West South Central which were unchanged.

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(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. June 30, 1970 data are preliminary.)

Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 312 million pounds on July 1, down 40 million from June 1 but 81 million more than a year earlier. Total pork holdings of 297 million pounds were down 53 million from a month earlier but 52 million above a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 67 million pounds, down 15 million from June 1 and 17 million below a year ago. Hams, at 36 million pounds, were 12 million below a month earlier but 19 million above a year ago.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks, at 242 million pounds, were up 28 million from a month earlier and 43 million above a year ago. Turkey stocks totaled 92 million pounds on July 1, up 18 million from June 1 but 28 million less than a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 70 million pounds, and parts, cut-ups and further processed turkey items totaled 22 million.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 188 million pounds, up 41 million from June 1, but 8 million less than a year earlier. Government-owned butter totaled 144 million pounds, up 37 million from June 1 but 10 million less than a year earlier.

American cheese holdings totaled 313 million pounds, up 32 million from a month earlier and 6 million above a year ago.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45^o brix equivalent) totaled 78 million gallons on July 1, up 7 million from June 1 and 17 million above a year earlier.

Fresh apple holdings totaled 48 million pounds, down 144 million from a month earlier but 3 million above a year earlier.

Frozen fruits totaled 497 million pounds, up 59 million from June 1 and 55 million above a year earlier. The largest decline during June was in frozen apples. The largest increase in stocks was recorded for strawberries.

Frozen vegetables stocks (excluding french fries) totaled 926 million pounds, up 24 million from June 1 but 48 million less than a year earlier. The largest increase in stocks was recorded for green peas. The largest decline was in corn.

French fried potato stocks totaled 479 million pounds, a decline of 87 million during June but 43 million above a year earlier.
