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Changes During July

Cold storage stocks increased during July for butter, cheese, frozen eggs, broilers, turkeys, cherries, strawberries, green beans and green peas. Commodities with decreases in stocks during July include apples, orange juice, corn, french fried potatoes, beef and pork.

Butter stocks increased 14 million pounds during July, cheese 16 million, frozen eggs 6 million, broilers 2 million, turkeys 62 million, cherries 72 million, strawberries 6 million, green beans 52 million and green peas 132 million pounds.

Decreases in stocks during July included apples 35 million pounds, orange juice 11 million gallons, corn 14 million pounds, french fried potatoes 141 million, beef 6 million, and pork 56 million pounds.

Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space on August 1 totaled 1,298 million pounds, down 58 million from July 1 and 10 million pounds below a year² earlier.

Stocks in freezer space totaled 4,615 million pounds on August 1, up 111 million from a month earlier and 443 million pounds above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 60 percent occupied on August 1, up 1 point from July 1 but 2 points below a year earlier. Compared with July 1, occupancy increased in New England, the East North Central, Mountain and Pacific Regions, but declined in the South Atlantic and South Central Regions. Other regions were unchanged.

Freezer space was 69 percent occupied on August 1, up 1 point from July 1 and 4 points above a year earlier. Freezer occupancy gained during July except in South Atlantic and Mountain Regions, where there were declines, and the West North Central which was unchanged.

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(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. July 31, 1970 data are preliminary.)

Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 311 million pounds on August 1, down 6 million from July 1 but 72 million more than a year earlier. Total pork holdings of 248 million pounds were down 56 million from a month earlier but 52 million above a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 39 million pounds, down 28 million from July 1 and 8 million below a year ago. Hams, at 31 million pounds, were 6 million below a month earlier but 15 million above a year ago.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks, at 322 million pounds, were up 72 million from a month earlier and 74 million above a year ago. Turkey stocks totaled 157 million pounds on August 1, up 62 million from July 1 but 5 million less than a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 132 million pounds, and parts, cut-ups and further processed turkey items totaled 26 million.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 200 million pounds, up 14 million from July 1, and 2 million above a year earlier. Government-owned butter totaled 164 million pounds, up 17 million from July 1 and 10 million above a year earlier.

American cheese holdings totaled 329 million pounds, up 14 million from a month earlier and 3 million above a year ago.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 68 million gallons on August 1, down 11 million from July 1 but 13 million above a year earlier.

Fresh apple holdings totaled 13 million pounds, down 35 million from a month earlier and 1 million below a year earlier.

Frozen fruits totaled 614 million pounds, up 102 million from July 1 and 74 million above a year earlier. The largest increase in stocks was recorded for cherries. The largest decline was in frozen apples.

Frozen vegetable stocks (excluding french fries) totaled 1,066 million pounds, up 138 million from July 1, but 38 million less than a year earlier. The largest increase in stocks was recorded for green peas. The largest decline was in spinach.

French fried potato stocks totaled 337 million pounds, a decline of 141 million during July but 21 million above a year earlier.
