## Changes During August

Cold storage stocks increased during August for pears, grapes, and frozen stocks of turkeys, cherries, lima beans, green beans, corn and green peas. Commodities with decreases in stocks include butter, cheese, strawberries, orange juice, french fried potatoes, beef and pork.

Stocks of pears increased 124 million pounds during August, grapes 64 million, turkeys 87 million, cherries 9 million, lima beans 28 million, green beans 80 million, corn 82 million, and green peas 33 million pounds.

Decreases in stocks during August included butter 6 million pounds, cheese 15 million, strawberries 15 million, french fried potatoes 57 million, beef 15 million, pork 39 million pounds and orange juice 10 million gallons.

## Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space on September 1 totaled 1,415 million pounds, up 103 million from August 1 but 118 million pounds below a year earlier.

Stocks in freezer space totaled 4,745 million pounds on September 1, up 84 million from a month earlier and 306 million pounds above a year earlier.

## Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 63 percent occupied on September 1, up 3 points from August 1, and the same as a year earlier. Cooler occupancy declined during August in each region except for a 13-point increase in the Pacific and a 1-point increase in the West South Central region.

Freezer space was 72 percent occupied on September 1, compared with 69 percent on August 1 and 68 percent a year earlier. Freezer occupancy gained during August in each region except for small declines in the South Atlantic and Mountain regions and no change in the West North Central region.

(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. August 31, 1970 data are preliminary.)

### Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 293 million pounds on September 1, down 15 million from August 1 but 27 million more than a year earlier. Total pork holdings of 216 million pounds were down 39 million from a month earlier but 47 million above a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 19 million pounds, down 20 million from August 1 and 2 million below a year ago. Hams at 25 million pounds, were 8 million below a month earlier but 10 million above a year ago.

### Poultry and Poultry Products

Total frozen poultry stocks, at 413 million pounds, were up 91 million from a month earlier and 89 million above a year ago. Frozen turkey stocks totaled 244 million pounds on September 1, up 87 million from August 1 and 6 million more than a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 208 million pounds, and parts, cut-ups and further processed turkey items totaled 36 million.

### Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 197 million pounds, down 6 million from August 1, and 12 million below a year earlier. Government-owned butter totaled 158 million pounds, down 9 million from August 1 but 16 million above a year earlier.

### Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 58 million gallons on September 1, down 10 million from August 1 but 10 million above a year earlier.

Fresh apple holdings totaled 16 million pounds, up 4 million from a month earlier but 1 million below a year earlier.

Frozen fruits totaled 647 million pounds, up 27 million from August 1 and 31 million above a year earlier. The largest increase in stocks was recorded for peaches. The largest decline was in strawberries.

Frozen vegetable stocks (excluding french fries) totaled 1,303 million pounds, up 235 million from August 1, but 38 million less than a year earlier. The largest increase in stocks was recorded for corn. The largest decline was in spinach.

French-fried potato stocks totaled 284 million pounds, a decline of 57 million during August but 21 million above a year earlier.

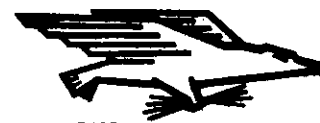
