Changes During September

Cold storage stocks increased during September for apples, pears, turkeys, lima beans, green beans, corn, and french-fried potatoes. Stocks decreased for butter, cheese, cherries, strawberries, orange juice, green peas, beef, and pork.

Stocks of apples increased 1,347 million pounds during September, pears, 214 million; turkeys, 100 million; lima beans, 57 million; green beans, 16 million; corn, 107 million, and french-fried potatoes, 51 million pounds.

Decreases in stocks during September included butter, 26 million pounds; cheese, 15 million; cherries, 9 million; strawberries, 13 million; green peas, 22 million; beef, 2 million; pork, 4 million pounds, and orange juice, 11 million gallons.

Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space totaled 2,840 million pounds on October 1, up 1,472 million from September 1 and 2 million pounds above a year earlier.

Stocks in freezer space totaled 5,037 million pounds on October 1, up 229 million from a month earlier and 332 million pounds above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 61 percent occupied on October 1, the same as a month earlier, but 1 point below a year earlier. Compared with September 1 occupancy increased in the Middle Atlantic, East North Central and Mountain Regions, but declined in the West North Central, East South Central and Pacific Regions. Other regions were unchanged.

Freezer space was 73 percent occupied on October 1, up 1 point from September 1 but the same as a year earlier. Freezer occupancy gained during September except in the New England and South Atlantic Regions, where there were declines, and the East North Central which was unchanged.

(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. September 30, 1970 data are preliminary.)

Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 289 million pounds on October 1, down 2 million from September 1 and 15 million less than a year earlier. Total pork holdings of 214 million pounds were down 4 million from a month earlier but 40 million above a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 9 million pounds, down 11 million from September 1 and 3 million below a year ago. Hams at 30 million pounds, were 5 million above both a month and a year earlier.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Total frozen poultry stocks, at 514 million pounds, were up 103 million from a month earlier and 91 million above a year ago. Frozen turkey stocks totaled 341 million pounds on October 1, up 100 million from September 1 and 11 million more than a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 298 million pounds, and parts, cut-ups and further processed turkey items totaled 43 million pounds.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 174 million pounds, down 26 million from September 1, but 18 million above a year earlier. Government-owned butter totaled 148 million pounds, down 13 million from September 1 but 27 million above a year earlier.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 47 million gallons on October 1, down 11 million from September 1 but 9 million above a year earlier.

Fresh apple holdings totaled 1,362 million pounds, up 1,347 million from a month earlier and 135 million above a year earlier.

Frozen fruits totaled 670 million pounds, up 14 million from September 1 and 48 million above a year earlier. The largest increase in stocks was recorded for "other frozen fruits." The largest decline was in strawberries.

Frozen vegetable stocks (excluding french fries) totaled 1,501 million pounds, up 198 million from September 1, but 67 million less than a year earlier. The largest increase in stocks was recorded for corn. The largest decline was in green peas.

French-fried potato stocks totaled 338 million pounds, an increase of 51 million from September 1 and 56 million above a year earlier.

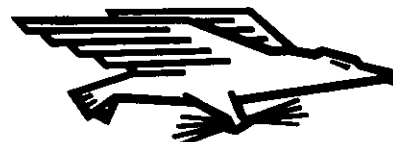
