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Changes During November

Cold storage stocks increased during November for french fried potatoes, beef and pork. Commodities showing decreases in stocks included apples, pears, grapes, butter, cheese, turkeys, orange juice, corn and green peas.

Stocks of french fried potatoes increased 77 million pounds during November, beef 5 million and pork 60 million pounds.

Decreases in stocks during November included apples 288 million pounds, pears 50 million, grapes 36 million, butter 12 million, cheese 14 million, turkeys 143 million, corn 34 million, green peas 26 million pounds and orange juice 7 million gallons.

Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space totaled 3,999 million pounds on December 1, down 310 million from November 1 and 433 million pounds below a year earlier. Stocks in freezer space totaled 4,967 million pounds, down 205 million from a month earlier but 313 million pounds above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public general warehouses was 64 percent occupied on December 1, down 1 point from November 1 and the same as a year earlier. Compared with November 1, cooler occupancy increased in the Middle Atlantic, East South Central, West South Central and Mountain regions. Cooler occupancy declined in New England, and the East North Central, West North Central and Pacific regions and held unchanged in the South Atlantic.

Freezer space was 75 percent occupied on December 1, unchanged from a month earlier but 3 points above a year earlier. Freezer occupancy gained in New England, and the South Atlantic and Mountain regions, held unchanged in the Middle Atlantic, West North Central, West South Central and Pacific regions and declined in the East North Central and East South Central regions.

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(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. November 30, 1970 data are preliminary.)

Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 305 million pounds on December 1, up 5 million from November 1 but 28 million less than a year earlier. Total pork holdings of 307 million pounds were up 60 million from a month earlier and 86 million above a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 43 million pounds, up 21 million from November 1 and 17 million above a year ago. Hams at 37 million, were down 1 million from a month earlier but 7 million above a year earlier.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Total frozen poultry stocks, at 467 million pounds, were down 157 million from a month earlier but 77 million above a year ago. Frozen turkey stocks totaled 303 million pounds on December 1, down 143 million from November 1 but 20 million above a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 262 million pounds, and parts, cut-ups and further processed turkey items totaled 41 million pounds.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 136 million pounds, down 12 million from November 1, but 31 million above a year earlier. Government-owned butter totaled 113 million pounds, down 12 million from November 1 but 28 million above a year earlier.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 29 million gallons on December 1, down 7 million from November 1 but 5 million above a year earlier.

Fresh apple holdings totaled 2,457 million pounds, down 288 million from a month earlier and 343 million less than a year earlier.

Frozen fruits totaled 650 million pounds, down 34 million from November 1 but 15 million above a year earlier. Apples showed the only gain in frozen fruit holdings. The largest volume decline during November was recorded for strawberries.

Frozen vegetable stocks (excluding french fries) totaled 1,444,431 million pounds, down 45 million from November 1 and 114 million less than a year earlier. The largest increase in stocks was recorded for carrots. The largest decline was in corn.

French fried potato stocks totaled 510 million pounds, an increase of 77 million from November 1 and 122 million above a year earlier.
