Changes During December

Cold storage stocks increased during December for orange juice, french fried potatoes, beef and pork. Commodities showing decreases in stocks from a month earlier include apples, butter, cheese, turkey, strawberries, corn and green peas.

Increases in stocks during December were french fried potatoes 48 million pounds, beef 13 million pounds, pork 40 million pounds, and orange juice 4 million gallons.

Decreases in stocks from a month earlier included apples 477 million pounds, butter 18 million, cheese 5 million, turkey 97 million, strawberries 17 million, corn 35 million and green peas 40 million pounds.

Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space totaled 3,456 million pounds on January 1, down 549 million from December 1 and 324 million pounds below a year earlier. Stocks in freezer space totaled 4,868 million pounds, down 137 million from a month earlier but 337 million pounds above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public general warehouses was 63 percent occupied on January 1, down 1 point from December 1 but 1 point above a year earlier. Compared with December 1, cooler occupancy increased in the West North Central Region, held unchanged in the East North Central, South Atlantic and East South Central Regions but declined in all other regions.

Freezer space was 72 percent occupied on January 1, down 2 points from a month earlier but 2 points above a year earlier. Freezer occupancy gained during December in the Mountain Region, held unchanged in the East North Central, South Atlantic, East South Central and West South Central Regions but declined in all other regions.

(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. December 31, 1970 data are preliminary.)

Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 330 million pounds on January 1, up 13 million from December 1 but 23 million less than a year earlier. Total pork holdings of 344 million pounds were up 40 million from a month earlier and 133 million above a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 79 million pounds, up 37 million from December 1 and 41 million above a year ago. Hams at 21 million, were down 16 million from a month earlier but 13 million above a year earlier.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Total frozen poultry stocks, at 390 million pounds, were down 96 million from a month earlier but 83 million above a year ago. Frozen turkey stocks totaled 216 million pounds on January 1, down 97 million from December 1 but 24 million above a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 177 million pounds, and parts, cut-ups and further processed items totaled 39 million pounds.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 116 million pounds, down 18 million from December 1, but 27 million above a year earlier. Government-owned butter totaled 101 million pounds, down 13 million from December 1 but 37 million above a year earlier.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 33 million gallons on January 1, up 4 million from December 1 and 5 million above a year earlier.

Fresh apple holdings totaled 1,980 million pounds, down 477 million from a month earlier and 256 million less than a year earlier.

Frozen fruits totaled 608 million pounds, down 41 million from December 1 but 22 million above a year earlier. Apples showed the only gain in frozen fruit holdings. The largest volume decline during December was recorded for strawberries.

Frozen vegetable stocks (excluding french fries) totaled 1,306 million pounds, down 140 million from December 1 and 149 million less than a year earlier. The largest decline was in green peas.

French fried potato stocks totaled 560 million pounds, an increase of 48 million from December 1 and 120 million above a year earlier.
