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## Changes During January

Cold storage stocks of orange juice and pork increased during January. Commodities showing decreases from a month earlier include fresh apples, butter, cheese, turkey, strawberries, corn, green peas and beef.

Increases in stocks during January were orange juice 14 million gallons, and pork 15 million pounds.

Decreases in stocks from a month earlier included fresh apples 404 million pounds, butter 3 million, cheese 8 million, turkey 14 million, strawberries 14 million, corn 33 million, green peas 33 million and beef 3 million pounds.

## Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space totaled 3,016 million pounds on February 1, down 434 million pounds from January 1 and 212 million pounds below a year earlier. Stocks in freezer space totaled 4,809 million pounds, down 54 million pounds from a month earlier, but 397 million pounds above a year earlier.

## Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public general warehouses was 61 percent occupied on February 1, down 1 point from January 1, but 1 point above a year earlier. Compared with January 1, cooler occupancy increased in the Pacific Region, held steady in the New England and West North Central Regions, but declined in other regions.

Freezer space was 70 percent occupied on February 1, down 2 points from a month earlier, but 2 points above a year earlier. Freezer occupancy gained in the South Atlantic Region, but declined in all other regions.

(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. January 31, 1971 data are preliminary.)

### Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 335 million pounds on February 1, down 3 million from January 1 and 33 million less than a year earlier. Total pork holdings of 352 million pounds were up 15 million from a month earlier and 141 million above a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 82 million pounds, up 5 million from January 1 and 45 million above a year earlier. Hams, at 34 million pounds, were up 14 million from a month earlier and 15 million above the same date in 1970.

### Poultry and Poultry Products

Total frozen poultry stocks, at 368 million pounds, were down 23 million pounds from January 1, but 95 million above a year earlier. Frozen turkey stocks totaled 205 million pounds, a decline of 14 million from a month earlier, but 43 million above February 1, 1970. Whole turkeys totaled 161 million pounds, and parts, cut-ups, and processed items totaled 43 million pounds.

### Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 115 million pounds, down 3 million from January 1, but 38 million above a year earlier. Government-owned butter totaled 91 million pounds, down 8 million from January 1, but 40 million more than on the same date in 1970.

### Fruits, Juices, and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 47 million gallons on February 1, up 14 million from January 1 and up 6 million from a year earlier.

Fresh apple holdings totaled 1,575 million pounds, down 404 million pounds from January 1 and 149 million less than a year earlier.

Frozen fruits in storage on February 1 totaled 573 million pounds, down 40 million from a month earlier, but 9 million above a year earlier. Apples showed the only increase in frozen fruit holdings during January. The largest volume decline during January was recorded for cherries.

Beginning with this report, frozen potatoes other than french fries are reported as a separate item. They were previously reported in other frozen vegetables or french fried potatoes. A total of 616 million pounds of frozen potatoes were reported in storage on February 1, of which 554 million pounds were french fries and 63 million pounds other frozen potatoes. The data on french fries are not comparable with previous dates.

Frozen vegetables (excluding french fried potatoes and other frozen potatoes) totaled 1,124 million pounds on February 1. Frozen vegetables totals for previous dates included some other frozen potatoes.
