Changes During February

Cold storage stocks increased during February for butter, orange juice and french fried potatoes, but declined for nearly all other commodities. Commodities showing decreases during February included fresh apples, cheese, turkeys, strawberries, corn, green peas, beef and pork.

Butter stocks increased 11 million pounds during February, french fried potatoes 16 million pounds and orange juice 12 million gallons.

Decreases during February included fresh apples 401 million pounds, cheese 11 million, turkeys 37 million, strawberries 19 million, corn 25 million, green peas 31 million, beef 22 million and pork 8 million pounds.

Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space totaled 2,553 million pounds on March 1, down 464 million pounds from February 1 and 144 million pounds below a year earlier. Stocks in freezer space totaled 4,723 million pounds, down 91 million pounds from a month earlier but 336 million pounds above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public general warehouses was 59 percent occupied on March 1, 1971. This is 2 points below a month earlier and 1 point below a year earlier. Compared with February 1, cooler occupancy increased in the New England and South Atlantic regions and declined in all other regions.

Freezer space was 68 percent filled on March 1, down 2 points from a month earlier, but 2 points above a year earlier. Freezer occupancy gained during February in the South Atlantic region, held unchanged in the East North Central region and declined in all other regions.

(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. February 28, 1971 data are preliminary.)

Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 304 million pounds on March 1, down 22 million from February 1 and 71 million less than a year earlier. Total pork holdings of 345 million pounds were down 8 million pounds from February 1 but 108 million pounds above a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 84 million pounds, up about one million pounds from February 1 and 37 million above a year earlier. Hams, at 36 million pounds, were 3 million pounds above a month earlier and 8 million above a year earlier.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks on March 1, totaled 328 million pounds, 41 million less than last month but 78 million more than a year earlier. Frozen turkey stocks totaled 169 million pounds, down 37 million from a month earlier but 36 million above a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 136 million pounds, and parts, cut-ups and processed items totaled 33 million pounds.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 130 million pounds, up 11 million pounds from February 1 and 49 million above a year earlier. Government-owned butter totaled 100 million pounds, up 8 million from a month earlier and 47 million above a year earlier.

Fruits, Juices, and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 57 million gallons, up 12 million gallons from February 1 and up 7 million from a year earlier.

Fresh apple holdings totaled 1,174 million pounds, down 402 million from February 1 and 88 million below a year earlier.

Frozen fruits in storage totaled 521 million pounds, down 51 million from a month earlier and 8 million below a year earlier. Frozen apples showed the only increase in frozen fruit holdings during February.

Frozen potatoes in storage totaled 642 million pounds. French fries accounted for 568 million and other frozen potatoes 74 million. The data on french fries are comparable only for March 1 and February 1, 1971.

Frozen vegetables (excluding potatoes) totaled 1,013 million pounds, down 137 million pounds from a month earlier.
