## Changes During March

Cold storage stocks increased during March for butter, french fried potatoes and pork, but declined for nearly all other commodities.

Butter stocks increased 24 million pounds during March, french fried potatoes 43 million and pork 44 million pounds.

Decreases during March included fresh apples 395 million pounds, cheese 12 million, turkeys 33 million, strawberries 8 million, corn 38 million, green peas 37 million, beef 6 million pounds and orange juice 1 million gallons.

## Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space totaled 2,122 million pounds on April 1, down 423 million from March 1 and 43 million pounds below a year earlier. Stocks in freezer space totaled 4,622 million pounds, down 93 million from a month earlier but 300 million pounds above a year earlier.

## Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 58 percent occupied on April 1, compared with 60 percent on March 1 and 59 percent a year earlier. Cooler occupancy increased during March in the West North Central and the East South Central regions. Occupancy was unchanged in the West South Central region. All other regions showed declines from a month earlier.

Freezer space was 68 percent occupied on April 1, unchanged from a month earlier and up 4 points from a year earlier. Freezer occupancy increased in the East North Central and South Atlantic regions. Occupancy was unchanged in the East South Central region and all other regions declined from a month earlier.

(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. March 31, 1971 data are preliminary.)

### ERRATA

On page 6 of the report issued March 17, 1971, figures for Total Frozen Vegetables should have been as follows --  
 Thousand pounds: February 1969 -- 1,190,359; February 1970 -- 1,142,727; January 1971 -- 1,149,332; February 1971 -- 1,012,713. Percentage change during February: 1969 -- 11 percent, 1970 - 9 percent, 1971 - 12 percent.

### Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 299 million pounds on April 1, down 6 million from March 1 and 81 million less than a year earlier. Total pork holdings of 389 million pounds were up 44 million from a month earlier and 120 million above a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 115 million pounds, up 30 million from March 1 and 54 million above a year earlier. Hams at 26 million pounds, were 10 million less than a month earlier but 2 million above a year earlier.

### Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks on April 1 totaled 290 million pounds, 40 million less than a month earlier but 68 million more than a year earlier. Turkey stocks totaled 141 million pounds, down 33 million from last month but 40 million more than a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 111 million pounds, 26 million less than a month earlier but 31 million more than a year earlier.

### Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 157 million pounds, an increase of 24 million from a month earlier and 66 million more than a year earlier. Government-owned butter totaled 124 million pounds, 22 million more than last month and 61 million more than a year earlier.

### Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 57 million gallons on April 1, down 1 million gallons from last month but up 10 million from a year earlier.

Fresh apple holdings at 779 million pounds, were 395 million pounds below last month and 31 million below a year earlier.

Frozen fruits totaled 473 million pounds, down 49 million from a month earlier and 16 million below a year earlier.

Frozen potatoes totaled 694 million pounds. French fries accounted for 615 million and other frozen potatoes 79 million. The data on frozen potatoes are comparable only for April 1 and March 1, 1971.

Frozen vegetables (excluding potatoes) totaled 907 million pounds, down 108 million from a month earlier.
