Changes During April

Cold storage stocks increased during April for butter, cheese and pork, but declined for nearly all other commodities.

Butter stocks increased 23 million pounds during April, cheese 16 million, and pork 80 million pounds.

Decreases during April included fresh apples 301 million pounds, turkeys 27 million, strawberries 13 million, corn 35 million, green peas 29 million, french fried potatoes 7 million pounds and orange juice down slightly.

Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space totaled 1,790 million pounds on May 1, down 305 million from April 1 and about the same as a year earlier. Stocks in freezer space totaled 4,628 million pounds, unchanged from April 1 and 223 million above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 58 percent occupied on May 1, down 1 point from April 1 and the same as a year earlier. Cooler occupancy increased during April in the West North Central, New England and Mountain regions. Occupancy was unchanged in the South Atlantic and East South Central regions. All other regions declined from a month earlier.

Freezer space was 67 percent occupied on May 1, up 1 point from April 1 and up 2 points from May 1, 1970. Freezer occupancy increased during April in the West North Central, South Atlantic, East South Central, Mountain and Pacific regions. Occupancy was unchanged in New England; all other regions recorded declines.

(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. April 30, 1971 data are preliminary.)

Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 292 million pounds on May 1, down 10 million from April 1 and 77 million less than a year earlier. Pork holdings totaled 469 million pounds, up 80 million from April 1 and 140 million above May 1, 1970. Frozen pork bellies totaled 133 million pounds, 20 million above last month and up 59 million from a year ago. Hams in cold storage almost doubled during April to 52 million pounds on May 1, 10 million more than May 1 last year.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks totaled 262 million pounds on May 1, 32 million less than a month earlier but 56 million more than May 1 last year. Turkey stocks at 117 million pounds, were 27 million less than last month but 35 million more than a year ago. Whole turkeys totaled 87 million pounds on May 1, a decline of 24 million during the month, but 26 million more than a year earlier.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 181 million pounds, an increase of 23 million during April and 66 million more than on May 1, 1970. Government-owned butter totaled 149 million pounds, up 27 million from April 1 and 73 million above a year ago.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 57 million gallons on May 1, down slightly from last month but 4 million more than a year ago.

Fresh apple holdings at 469 million pounds, were 301 million less than last month, but 22 million above May 1, 1970.

Frozen fruits totaled 428 million pounds, a drop of 54 million during April and 37 million below a year ago.

Frozen vegetables (excluding potatoes) totaled 832 million pounds on May 1, down 70 million from last month.

Frozen potatoes totaled 704 million pounds. French fries accounted for 614 million and other frozen potatoes 90 million. Data on frozen potatoes are not comparable with previous years.
