Changes During May

Cold storage stocks increased during May for orange juice, butter, pork, cheese, and frozen potatoes but declined for most other commodities.

Orange juice stocks increased 7 million gallons during May, butter 32 million pounds, pork 30 million pounds, cheese 24 million pounds, and frozen potatoes 13 million pounds.

Decreases during May included fresh apples 238 million pounds, corn 28 million, green peas 15 million, green beans 12 million and beef 6 million pounds.

Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space totaled 1,577 million pounds on June 1, down 210 million pounds from May 1 but up 43 million pounds from June 1, 1970. Freezer stocks on June 1 totaled 4,688 million pounds, up 49 million pounds from May 1 and 175 million pounds above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 59 percent occupied on June 1, up 1 point from May 1 and a year earlier. Cooler occupancy increased during May in 5 regions, was unchanged in the West South Central and decreased in the Middle Atlantic, South Atlantic and East South Central regions.

Freezer space was 67 percent occupied on June 1, 1 point above last month and June 1, 1970. Freezer occupancy was up in the New England, Middle Atlantic, East North Central and South Atlantic regions and unchanged or lower in other regions.

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(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. May 31, 1971 data are preliminary.)

Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 285 million pounds on June 1, down 6 million from May 1 and 68 million less than a year earlier. Total pork holdings of 497 million pounds were up 30 million from a month earlier and 147 million above a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 149 million pounds, up 15 million from May 1 and 67 million above a year ago. Hams, at 59 million pounds, were 9 million above a month earlier and 12 million above a year ago.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks, at 254 million pounds, were down 11 million from a month earlier but 42 million above a year ago. Turkey stocks totaled 115 million pounds on June 1, down 5 million from May 1 but 41 million more than a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 87 million pounds, and parts, cut-ups and further processed turkey items totaled 27 million.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 213 million pounds, up 32 million from May 1 and 66 million above a year earlier. Government-owned butter totaled 179 million pounds, up 21 million from May 1 and 72 million more than a year earlier.

American cheese holdings totaled 270 million pounds, up 22 million from a month earlier but 12 million below a year ago.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 64 million gallons on June 1, up 7 million from May 1 but 6 million below a year earlier.

Fresh apple holdings totaled 231 million pounds, down 238 million from a month earlier but 40 million above a year earlier.

Frozen fruits totaled 381 million pounds, down 48 million from May 1 and 53 million below last year.

Frozen vegetable stocks (excluding potatoes) totaled 800 million pounds, down 56 million from May 1.

Frozen potatoes totaled 730 million pounds. French fries accounted for 639 million and other frozen potatoes 91 million. Data on frozen potatoes are not comparable with previous years.
