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## Changes During June

Cold storage stocks increased during June for strawberries, green peas, orange juice, cheese, turkeys and butter. Stock decreases included fresh apples, frozen french fried potatoes, red meats, most frozen fruits, and cream.

Frozen strawberry stocks increased 81 million pounds, green peas 54 million, cheese 36 million, turkeys 32 million, butter 26 million, and orange juice increased 4 million gallons.

Decreases in stocks during June included fresh apples 153 million pounds, frozen french fried potatoes 51 million, and red meats 11 million pounds.

## Total Cooler and Freezer Space

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space on July 1 totaled 1,430 million pounds, down 167 million from June 1 but 74 million pounds above a year earlier. Stocks in freezer space totaled 4,822 million pounds on July 1, up 153 million from a month earlier and 302 million pounds above a year ago.

## Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 58 percent occupied on July 1, one point less than both a month and a year earlier. Gains in cooler stocks from June 1 in the Middle Atlantic, East North Central, West North Central and Mountain regions were more than offset by declines in all other regions except New England where occupancy was unchanged.

Freezer space was 67 percent occupied on July 1, unchanged from last month but 1 point below July 1, 1970. Freezer occupancy declined in the New England, Middle Atlantic and Mountain regions. All other regions showed increases during June.

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(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. June 30, 1971 data are preliminary.)

### Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 292 million pounds on July 1, up 7 million pounds from June 1 but 27 million pounds below July 1, 1970. Total pork holdings of 482 million pounds were down 17 million from the previous month but 177 million pounds above a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 141 million pounds, down 8 million from June 1 but 75 million pounds above a year earlier. Hams, at 57 million pounds, were down 3 million from last month but 20 million pounds above a year ago.

### Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks, at 291 million pounds, were up 39 million pounds from June 1 and 42 million pounds above a year ago. Turkey stocks totaled 144 million pounds, up 32 million from a month earlier and 49 million more than a year ago. Whole turkeys totaled 111 million pounds and parts, cut-ups and further processed turkey items totaled 33 million.

### Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 236 million pounds on July 1, up 26 million from June 1, and 50 million above a year earlier. Government-owned butter totaled 203 million pounds, up 27 million from June 1 and 56 million above a year ago.

American cheese holdings totaled 297 million pounds, up 29 million pounds from a month earlier but 16 million pounds below a year ago.

### Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 68 million gallons on July 1, up 4 million from a month earlier but 10 million below a year ago.

Fresh apple holdings totaled 85 million pounds, down 153 million from a month earlier but 37 million above a year earlier.

Frozen fruits totaled 438 million pounds, up 53 million from June 1 but 72 million below last year.

Frozen vegetable stocks (excluding potatoes) totaled 828 million pounds, up 28 million from last month.

Frozen potatoes totaled 683 million pounds. French fried potatoes accounted for 592 million and other frozen potatoes 90 million. Data on frozen potatoes are not comparable with previous years.
