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Changes During September

Cold storage stocks increased during September for apples, pears, lima beans, green beans, corn, french-fried potatoes, turkeys, and beef. Decreases were recorded for butter, cheese, frozen apples, cherries, orange juice, green peas, and pork.

Stocks of apples increased 725 million pounds during September; pears, 197 million; lima beans, 35 million; green beans, 9 million; corn, 89 million; french-fried potatoes, 66 million; turkeys, 74 million; and beef, 15 million pounds.

Decreases in stocks during September included butter, 20 million pounds; cheese, 18 million; frozen apples, 11 million; cherries, 10 million; green peas, 15 million; pork, 21 million pounds; and orange juice, 8 million gallons.

Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space totaled 2,330 million pounds on October 1, up 875 million from September 1 but 551 million pounds below a year earlier.

Stocks in freezer space totaled 5,211 million pounds on October 1, 113 million above September 1 and 168 million above October 1, 1970.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 62 percent occupied on October 1, up 1 point from last month and 2 points above a year earlier. Occupancy declined during September in the Pacific and New England regions, was unchanged in the West North Central and West South Central regions, and increased in all other regions.

Freezer space was 72 percent occupied on October 1, up 2 points from last month but the same as a year ago. Freezer occupancy declined during September in the New England and South Atlantic regions, was unchanged in the East North Central and West South Central, and increased in all other regions.

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(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. September 30, 1971 data are preliminary.)

Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 348 million pounds on October 1, up 15 million from September 1 and 61 million above a year earlier. Total pork holdings were 311 million pounds on October 1, down 21 million from a month ago but 101 million pounds above October 1, 1970. Frozen pork bellies, at 53 million pounds, decreased 18 million during September but were 43 million pounds above a year earlier. Hams totaled 50 million pounds, up 5 million during September and 23 million above October 1 a year ago.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks on October 1 totaled 542 million pounds, 80 million above September 1 and 26 million more than a year earlier. Frozen turkey stocks were 382 million pounds on October 1, up 74 million from September 1 and 39 million above a year ago. Whole turkeys accounted for 87 percent of the total turkey stocks compared with 84 percent on September 1 and 88 percent a year earlier.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 227 million pounds on October 1, down 20 million from September 1 but 55 million above a year earlier. Government-owned butter stocks totaled 199 million pounds compared with 215 million on September 1 and 145 million on October 1, 1970.

Fruits, Juices, and Vegetables

Stocks of orange juice concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 46 million gallons on October 1, down 8 million from September 1 and 1-1/2 million below a year earlier.

Fresh apple holdings totaled 739 million pounds on October 1 compared with 14 million on September 1 and 1,366 million on October 1, 1970.

Frozen fruit stocks totaled 593 million pounds on October 1, down 23 million from a month earlier and 72 million from a year earlier. The largest increase in frozen fruit stocks during September was recorded for peaches. The largest decrease was in strawberries.

Stocks of frozen vegetables (excluding french fries) totaled 1,331 million pounds on October 1 compared with 1,206 on September 1 and 1,473 million a year earlier. During September the largest increase was for corn and the largest decline was in green peas.

Frozen potato stocks totaled 457 million pounds. French fried potatoes accounted for 386 million pounds, up 66 million from September 1, and other frozen potatoes totaled 71 million pounds. Data on frozen potatoes are not comparable with previous years.
