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Changes During October

Cold storage stocks increased during October for fresh apples, grapes, turkeys, frozen apples, carrots, corn and french fried potatoes. Stocks decreased for butter, cheese, cherries, strawberries, green beans, green peas, and orange juice. Total stocks of red meat declined slightly during October.

Stocks of fresh apples increased 1,931 million pounds during October, grapes 65 million, turkeys 88 million, frozen apples 7 million, carrots 29 million, corn 22 million and french fried potatoes 111 million pounds.

Decreases in stocks during October included butter 38 million pounds, cheese 22 million, frozen cherries 11 million, strawberries 15 million, green beans 16 million, green peas 27 million pounds, and orange juice 11 million gallons. Total stocks of red meat in storage declined 3 million pounds.

Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space totaled 4,352 million pounds on November 1, up 83 percent from October 1 and 1 percent above a year earlier.

Stocks in freezer space on November 1 totaled 5,476 million pounds, 3 percent above October 1 and 6 percent more than a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 64 percent occupied on November 1, up 3 points from last month but 1 point below November 1 a year ago. Compared with October 1, cooler occupancy increased sharply in the Mid-Atlantic region and made smaller gains in the New England, South Atlantic and East South Central regions. Cooler occupancy declined 5 points in the Pacific region and was down slightly in the remaining regions.

Freezer space was 72 percent occupied on November 1, the same as last month but 3 points below a year earlier. Freezer occupancy declined 1 point in the Mid-Atlantic, South Atlantic and West South Central regions but increased slightly in all other regions.

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(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. October 31, 1971 data are preliminary.)

Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 351 million pounds on November 1, up slightly from October 1 and 51 million pounds above a year earlier. Pork stocks totaled 308 million pounds, down less than 1 million during October but 62 million pounds above November 1, 1970. Frozen pork bellies totaled 53 million pounds, up 1 million from October 1 and 32 million pounds above a year earlier. Frozen hams, at 56 million pounds, were up 6 million from a month earlier and 17 million above a year earlier.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Total frozen poultry stocks, at 640 million pounds, were up 93 million from October 1 and 12 million above a year ago. Frozen turkeys totaled 477 million pounds, up 88 million during October and 27 million above November 1, 1970. Whole turkeys accounted for 431 million pounds and parts, cut-up and further processed turkeys totaled 46 million pounds.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 184 million pounds on November 1, down 38 million from October 1 but 37 million above a year earlier. Government owned stocks totaled 156 million pounds, down 39 million during October but 30 million above a year earlier. Natural cheese stocks totaled 262 million pounds, down 22 million from October 1 and 3 million below a year earlier.

Juices, Fruits and Vegetables

Stocks of orange juice concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 34 million gallons, down 11 million from October 1 and 1 million less than a year earlier.

Fresh apple holdings totaled 2,738 million pounds on November 1, up 1,931 million from a month earlier but 7 million pounds less than a year ago.

Frozen fruits totaled 663 million pounds, up 46 million from October 1 but 21 million less than a year earlier. Largest increases were reported for apples and grapes. The largest decreases were for strawberries and cherries.

Frozen vegetable stocks (excluding potatoes) totaled 1,430 million pounds, 55 million above a month earlier but 60 million less than on November 1, 1970. The largest increases were reported for carrots and corn. Largest declines were for green peas and green beans.

Frozen potato stocks totaled 572 million pounds, up 123 million from October 1. French fried potatoes accounted for 492 million pounds, and other frozen potatoes totaled 80 million pounds. Data on frozen potatoes are not comparable with previous years.
