## Changes During April

Cold storage stocks increased during April for butter, cheese, orange juice, asparagus, spinach, french-fried potatoes, and pork.

Stocks with decreases included fresh apples, turkeys, green beans, corn, and green peas.

Butter stocks increased 21 million pounds, cheese 23 million, asparagus 7 million, spinach 27 million, french-fried potatoes 64 million, pork 68 million, and orange juice 3 million gallons.

Decreases during April included fresh apples 307 million pounds, turkeys 25 million, green beans 15 million, corn 33 million, and green peas 13 million pounds.

## Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space totaled 1,831 million pounds on May 1, 14 percent less than on April 1 but 5 percent more than a year earlier. Freezer stocks totaled 4,585 million pounds, up 2 percent from April 1 but 1 percent less than a year ago.

## Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 57 percent occupied on May 1, 1972, the same as last month and 1 point below a year earlier. Cooler occupancy increased in the New England, East North Central, West North Central, and East South Central regions, while it declined in the Middle Atlantic and Pacific regions. All other regions were unchanged from last month.

Freezer space in public warehouses was 64 percent occupied on May 1, 1972, the same as last month and 2 points below a year earlier. Freezer occupancy declined in the South Atlantic region and increased in the Middle Atlantic, East North Central, West North Central, East South Central, and Mountain regions. All other regions were unchanged from last month.

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(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. April 30, 1972 data are preliminary.)

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### Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 279 million pounds, 1 million more than on April 1 but 2 million less than a year earlier. Pork holdings increased 68 million pounds to 399 million during April but were 64 million less than a year ago. Frozen pork bellies at 132 million pounds were up 22 percent from last month and nearly the same as a year earlier. Hams increased 88 percent during April but were 5 percent less than a year ago.

### Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks declined 10 percent during April to 238 million pounds, compared with 266 million on April 1 and 265 million on May 1, 1971. Turkey stocks at 121 million pounds decreased 17 percent but were nearly the same as a year earlier. Whole turkey stocks on May 1 totaled 95 million pounds, a drop of 21 million during the month. Chicken stocks declined 2 percent to 115 million pounds.

### Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 131 million pounds, 21 million more than on April 1 but 49 million less than a year ago. Government-owned stocks totaled 98 million pounds, 13 million more than last month but 61 million less than a year earlier.

### Juices, Fruits and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 54 million gallons, up 3 million from April 1 but 3 million less than a year ago.

Fresh apple holdings at 478 million pounds declined 307 million during April but were 10 million more than a year earlier.

Frozen fruit stocks totaled 406 million pounds, 43 million less than a month ago and 22 million less than a year ago.

Frozen vegetables (excluding potatoes) totaled 821 million pounds, down 66 million pounds from April 1 and 41 million below May 1, 1971.

Frozen potato stocks totaled 870 million pounds, 68 million more than last month and 151 million above last year. French-fried potato stocks made up 88 percent of the total, compared with 87 percent on April 1 and a year ago.
