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## Changes During May

Cold storage stocks increased during May for butter, asparagus, broccoli, and orange juice.

Butter stocks increased 28 million pounds, asparagus 9 million, broccoli 25 million pounds, and orange juice 13 million gallons.

Stocks of fresh apples decreased 240 million pounds during May, turkeys 12 million, green beans 11 million, corn 20 million, green peas 16 million, and french-fried potatoes 38 million pounds.

## Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space totaled 1,589 million pounds on June 1, down 249 million from May 1 but only 7 million less than June 1 last year. Total freezer stocks totaled 4,606 million pounds, up 19 million during May but 67 million less than on June 1, 1971.

## Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 57 percent occupied on June 1, the same as last month but 2 points below a year earlier. Cooler occupancy increased in the East North Central, West North Central, West South Central, and Pacific regions. Occupancy declined in all other regions.

Freezer space in public warehouses was 65 percent occupied on June 1, the same as last month but 2 points below a year earlier. Freezer occupancy increased in the New England and Pacific regions, was down in the Middle Atlantic and West North Central. All other regions were unchanged from a month earlier.

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(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. May 31, 1972 data are preliminary.)

### Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 276 million pounds on June 1, 2 percent less than a month earlier and 3 percent lower than a year ago. At 383 million pounds, pork holdings were 3 percent below May 1 and 23 percent less than a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 133 million pounds, up 2 percent from May 1 but 9 percent less than June 1, 1971.

### Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks declined 10 percent during May to 214 million pounds, compared with 251 million pounds a year earlier. Total turkey stocks were 109 million pounds, down 12 million from May 1 and 3 million less than a year ago. Total frozen chicken stocks declined 11 percent during May to 102 million pounds. Total frozen egg stocks totaled 80 million pounds on June 1, 10 percent more than on May 1 and 19 percent above a year earlier.

### Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 159 million pounds on June 1, up 28 million from May 1 but 51 million less than a year ago. Government-owned stocks of butter totaled 124 million pounds, 27 percent more than a month earlier. Total natural cheese stocks were 349 million pounds, up 38 million during May and 12 million more than a year ago.

### Juices, Fruits and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 72 million gallons, 13 million more than a month earlier and 8 million more than a year ago.

Fresh apple stocks decreased 240 million pounds during May to 235 million on June 1.

Frozen fruit stocks totaled 358 million pounds on June 1, 39 million less than on May 1 and 26 million below a year earlier.

Frozen vegetable stocks (excluding potatoes) totaled 813 million pounds, 3 percent less than a month ago but up 1 percent from a year ago.

French-fried potato stocks totaled 706 million pounds on June 1, 38 million less than on May 1 but 60 million above a year ago. Total frozen potato stocks decreased 5 percent during May.
