## Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space totaled 1,408 million pounds on June 30, down 13 percent from a month earlier and 2 percent below a year ago. Stocks in freezer space totaled 4,683 million pounds, up 2 percent during June but 4 percent below a year earlier.

## Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 57 percent occupied on June 30, the same as last month but down from 59 percent a year earlier. Cooler occupancy increased in the New England, East North Central and Mountain regions, declined in the Middle Atlantic, South Atlantic and Pacific regions. All other regions were unchanged.

Freezer space in public warehouses was 65 percent occupied on June 30, the same as last month but down from 67 percent last year. Freezer occupancy increased in the South Atlantic region and was unchanged in the East North Central, East South Central and West South Central regions. All other regions declined during the month of June.

## CHANGES IN THIS ISSUE

5. Reported occupancy in public warehouses on page 11 has been expanded from 25 to 35 metropolitan areas.

### Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 253 million pounds on June 30, down 8 percent from a month earlier and 15 percent below a year ago. Pork stocks decreased 16 percent during June to 319 million pounds at the end of the month. This is about one-third below the year-earlier total. Holdings of pork bellies dropped 20 percent during June to 106 million pounds, 25 percent below a year earlier.

### Poultry and Eggs

Stocks of frozen chicken increased 5 percent during June to 107 million pounds. Broilers, fryers and roasters increased 8 percent while stocks of hens declined slightly. Total frozen chicken stocks were 24 percent below a year earlier. Stocks of frozen turkey increased 25 percent during June to 138 million pounds, slightly below holdings on June 30, 1971. Stocks of frozen eggs increased 6 percent to 85 million pounds on June 30, which was 14 percent above a year ago.

### Dairy Products

Butter stocks increased 22 percent during June to 194 million pounds at the end of the month, 18 percent below a year earlier. Government-owned butter stocks increased 23 percent during the month to 157 million pounds, 22 percent below a year ago.

Stocks of natural American cheese gained 10 percent during June to 304 million pounds on June 30, up 3 percent from a year earlier. Swiss cheese stocks increased 6 percent to 10 million pounds at the end of June, 10 percent less than a year ago.

### Fruit and Vegetables

Fresh apple stocks declined 152 million pounds during June to 83 million pounds at the end of the month, 4 percent below a year earlier.

Stocks of orange concentrate totaled 83 million gallons on June 30, up 16 percent from a month earlier and 22 percent above a year ago.

Frozen strawberry stocks increased 55 percent during June, less than the usual gain. Holdings of 145 million pounds on June 30 were 18 percent below a year earlier. Stocks of frozen apricots and boysenberries showed larger than usual gains during June this year.

Frozen vegetables showing seasonal increases during June included asparagus, broccoli, blackeye peas, green peas and southern greens. June 30 stocks of frozen vegetables totaled 835 million pounds, slightly below a year earlier.

Stocks of frozen french-fried potatoes declined 17 percent during June to 586 million pounds at the end of the month, slightly below a year earlier. Stocks of other frozen potatoes totaled 95 million pounds on June 30, up 12 percent from a year ago.
