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## Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space on September 30 totaled 2,408 million pounds, 69 percent more than a month earlier and 1 percent above a year earlier. Total freezer stocks were 5,184 million pounds, 4 percent above August 31 but 2 percent less than a year ago.

## Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 57 percent occupied on September 30, compared with 60 percent last month and 61 percent a year earlier. During September cooler occupancy increased in the East South Central and Mountain regions, was unchanged in the Middle Atlantic and West South Central regions, and declined in all other regions.

Freezer space was 68 percent occupied on September 30, up 1 point from last month and 4 points below a year earlier. Occupancy decreased in the South Atlantic region, was unchanged in the East North Central, West South Central, and Pacific regions, and increased in all other regions.

## Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 297 million pounds, 6 percent above August 31 but 15 percent below September 30, 1971. Pork stocks declined 14 million pounds to 191 million during September. This was 7 percent less than a month earlier and 38 percent below a year ago. Pork bellies totaled 17 million pounds, 52 percent less than a month ago and only one-third of the quantity a year earlier.

## Poultry and Eggs

Stocks of frozen chickens totaled 105 million pounds, up 3 percent from August 31 but 30 percent less than a year ago. Turkey stocks were 410 million pounds, 31 percent more than a month earlier and 5 percent above a year ago. Stocks of whole turkeys increased 32 percent during September and other turkey increased 21 percent. Frozen egg stocks declined 7 percent during September to 83 million pounds and were 2 percent less than a year ago.

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### Dairy Products

At 177 million pounds on September 30, butter stocks were down 11 percent from a month earlier and 20 percent less than a year ago. Government-owned stocks decreased 8 percent during the month. Natural cheese stocks totaled 396 million pounds, 3 percent less than a month ago but were 11 percent above a year earlier.

### Fruit and Vegetables

Stocks of frozen orange juice concentrate totaled 61 million gallons, 17 percent less than on August 31 but 35 percent above a year ago.

Total frozen fruit stocks declined 1 percent during September and were 14 percent less than a year earlier. Largest decreases during September were in frozen apples, cherries, and strawberries. Significant increases were in the stocks of blackberries, 14 percent; blueberries, 17 percent; grapes, 51 percent; peaches, 14 percent; and other frozen fruits, 20 percent.

Frozen vegetable stocks increased 15 percent during September to 1,405 million pounds, 2 percent above a year earlier. Significant increases in stocks were reported for all lima beans, 72 percent; all green beans, 19 percent; brussels sprouts, 58 percent; carrots, 15 percent; all corn, 69 percent; okra, 19 percent; southern greens, 12 percent; and other frozen vegetables, 11 percent. The largest decreases in stocks were for asparagus, green peas, and spinach.

At 416 million pounds, stocks of frozen french-fried potatoes were 19 percent above last month and 9 percent above a year ago. Other frozen potato stocks increased 9 percent during September and were up 8 percent from a year earlier.

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Data for this report are collected from refrigerated storages, public or private, where food products are normally stored for 30 days or more. Stocks in space owned or leased by the armed forces are not reported.
