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Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space on October 31 totaled 3,890 million pounds, 63 percent more than a month ago but 11 percent below a year earlier. Total freezer stocks were 5,471 million pounds, 4 percent above September 30 and 1 percent more than October 31, 1971.

Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 328 million pounds, 9 percent more than a month earlier but 5 percent below a year ago. Pork stocks increased 24 million pounds to 216 million pounds. This was 12 percent more than on September 30 but 30 percent less than a year earlier. Pork belly holdings totaled 22 million pounds, 31 percent above last month but 59 percent below a year ago.

Poultry and Eggs

Stocks of frozen chicken totaled 111 million pounds, 3 percent above a month earlier but 27 percent less than a year ago. Turkey stocks were 472 million pounds on October 31, up 16 percent from September 30 but 1 percent below a year earlier. Stocks of whole turkeys increased 15 percent during October and other turkey increased 19 percent. Frozen egg stocks declined 5 percent during the month to 80 million pounds and were 3 percent below a year ago.

Dairy Products

At 148 million pounds on October 31, 1972, butter stocks declined 17 percent from September 30 and were 21 percent below a year ago. Government stocks of butter were down 18 percent from the previous month and 15 percent from a year earlier. Natural cheese stocks totaled 380 million pounds, down 6 percent from a month earlier but 14 percent above a year ago.

Fruits and Vegetables

Stocks of frozen orange juice concentrate totaled 48 million gallons, 20 percent less than a month ago but 40 percent above a year earlier.

Total frozen fruit stocks increased 7 percent during October to 548 million pounds but were 16 percent less than a year ago. Largest increases in stocks were reported for apples, grapes and other frozen fruits.

Fresh apple stocks increased 156 percent during October to 2,442 million pounds but were 11 percent less than a year ago. Apples in regular storage totaled 1,657 million pounds and controlled-atmosphere stored apples were 786 million pounds.

Frozen vegetable stocks increased 66 million pounds to 1,504 million pounds, up 5 percent both from last month and a year ago. Largest increases during October were reported for baby lima beans, brussels sprouts, carrots and cauliflower.

Frozen french-fried potatoes totaled 527 million pounds, 31 percent above a month ago and 9 percent above a year earlier. Other frozen potato stocks increased 19 percent and 18 percent, respectively, from a month earlier and a year ago.

Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Stocks of all commodities in public warehouses totaled 4,541 million pounds or 49 percent of all stocks in all warehouses. Cooler stocks totaled 813 million pounds and freezer stocks totaled 3,727 million pounds.

Cooler space in public warehouses was 59 percent occupied on October 31, 1972. This compares with 56 percent occupied last month and 64 percent a year earlier. During October cooler occupancy increased in the Middle Atlantic, South Atlantic, East South Central, and Mountain regions. The largest gain was in the Middle Atlantic region. Occupancy in all other regions decreased.

Freezer space was 70 percent occupied on October 31, compared with 69 percent last month and 73 percent a year earlier. Occupancy increased in all other regions except in the West North Central and Pacific regions. The largest gain occurred in New England.

Data for this report are collected from refrigerated storages, public or private where food products are normally stored for 30 days or more. Stocks in space owned or leased by the armed forces are not reported.
