Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space on November 30 totaled 3,577 million pounds, 7 percent less than a month ago and 12 percent below a year earlier. Total freezer stocks were 5,245 million pounds, 5 percent less than October 31, but 3 percent above a year earlier.

Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 343 million pounds, 8 percent more than on both a month ago and a year earlier. Pork stocks increased 16 percent during November to 242 million pounds, 74 percent of November 30, 1971. Pork belly holdings totaled 35 million pounds, an increase of 60 percent during the past month but only 52 percent of a year earlier.

Poultry and Eggs

Stocks of frozen chicken totaled 109 million pounds, 1 percent less than a month earlier and 27 percent below a year earlier. Turkey stocks totaled 304 million pounds, 64 percent of the stocks on October 31 and 98 percent of November 30, 1971. Stocks of whole turkeys decreased 40 percent and other turkeys were down 6 percent from a month earlier. Frozen egg stocks declined 5 percent during November and were also 5 percent below a year earlier.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks declined 20 percent during November to 124 million pounds, down 20 percent from a year earlier. Government stocks of butter also declined 20 percent during the past month. Natural cheese stocks totaled 353 million pounds, down 7 percent from October but 11 percent above a year earlier.

Fruits and Vegetables

Stocks of frozen orange juice concentrate totaled 41 million gallons, 19 percent less than October 31 but 58 percent above a year earlier.

Total frozen fruit stocks decreased 5 percent during the month to 528 million pounds, 15 percent less than a year earlier. Stocks of all frozen fruit items decreased except apples which increased 35 percent from a month earlier.

Fresh apple stocks totaled 2,222 million pounds, down 9 percent from month earlier and 13 percent less than November 30, 1971. Stocks of apples in controlled atmosphere storage increased 8 percent since October 31 while regular storage declined 17 percent.

Frozen vegetable stocks totaled 1,464 million pounds on November 30, 3 percent less than a month earlier but 8 percent above a year earlier. Large increases for brussels sprouts, carrots, and cauliflower were offset by declines for most other frozen vegetable items.

Frozen french fries totaled 577 million pounds, up 13 percent from last month and 5 percent above a year earlier. Other frozen potato stocks decreased 3 percent during the month but were 10 percent above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Stocks of all commodities in public warehouses totaled 4,364 million pounds or 49 percent of the total stocks held in all warehouses. Cooler stocks totaled 799 million pounds and freezer stocks totaled 3,565 million pounds.

Cooler space in public warehouses was 59 percent occupied on November 30, 1972, the same as last month but 5 points below last year. Cooler occupancy increased in the Middle Atlantic, South Atlantic, East South Central, and Mountain regions. There was no change in the West North Central and West South Central regions; all other regions showed declines with New England down 4 points.

Freezer space was 71 percent occupied on November 30, down 1 point from last month but 1 point above last year. Freezer occupancy declined in all but the East North Central region where no change was recorded.

Stocks in Public General Warehouses, March-May, 1972

The stocks data for public general warehouses in the table below were not available at the time of previous reports while the data processing system was being changed. These data are comparable with revised monthly stocks in all warehouses. Stocks in public warehouses are now published currently in the same table with preliminary stocks in all warehouses.
