## Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space on December 31 totaled 2,987 million pounds, 16 percent less than a month ago and 15 percent below a year earlier. Total freezer stocks were 5,003 million pounds, 5 percent less than November 30 but 3 percent above a year earlier.

## Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 373 million pounds, 6 percent more than a month ago and 2 percent above December 31, 1971. Total pork stocks declined 17 million pounds to 226 million during December. This was 7 percent less than a month earlier and 32 percent below a year ago. Pork belly holdings totaled 40 million pounds, 16 percent above last month but 54 percent below a year earlier.

## Poultry and Eggs

Stocks of frozen chicken totaled 113 million pounds, up 2 percent from November 30 but 24 percent less than a year ago. Turkey stocks were 210 million pounds, 29 percent below November 30 stocks and 6 percent less than a year earlier. Stocks of whole turkeys dropped 33 percent during December and other turkeys declined 10 percent. Frozen egg stocks decreased 11 percent during December to 68 million pounds.

## Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 102 million pounds on December 31, down 23 percent from last month but 5 percent above a year earlier. Government stocks of butter declined 24 percent during the past month. Natural cheese stocks totaled 328 million pounds, down 7 percent from November but 8 percent above a year earlier.

### Fruits and Vegetables

Stocks of frozen orange juice concentrate totaled 42 million gallons, 2 percent less than a month earlier but 45 percent above a year ago.

Total frozen fruit stocks decreased 5 percent during December to 512 million pounds, 12 percent less than a year earlier. Stocks of all frozen fruit items decreased except apples and grapes which were above a month earlier.

Fresh apple stocks declined 22 percent during the past month to 1,740 million pounds and were 17 percent less than on December 31, 1971. Stocks of apples in controlled atmosphere declined 1 percent but were 2 percent above a year earlier.

Frozen vegetable stocks totaled 1,320 million pounds, 10 percent less than on November 30 but 6 percent above a year earlier. Nearly all stocks of frozen vegetables registered declines during December except brussels sprouts, mixed vegetables, black-eye peas, and southern greens for which the stocks increased.

Frozen french fries increased 2 percent during December to 592 million pounds, 3 percent above a year earlier. Other frozen potato stocks totaled 94 million pounds, 10 percent and 8 percent above last month and a year earlier, respectively.

### Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Stocks of all commodities in public warehouses totaled 4,155 million pounds or 52 percent of the total stocks held in all warehouses. Cooler stocks totaled 743 million pounds and freezer stocks totaled 3,413 million pounds.

Cooler space in public warehouses was 57 percent occupied on December 31. This compares with 58 percent last month and 62 percent a year ago. During December, cooler occupancy increased in the New England, South Atlantic, and East South Central but decreased in all other regions.

Freezer space was 69 percent occupied on December 31, compared with 71 percent last month and 68 percent on December 31, 1971. Occupancy decreased in all regions except the New England region where it remained the same.
