Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Commodities in cooler space April 30 totaled 1,490 million pounds, 14 percent less than March 31 and 20 percent below last year. Freezer stocks fell 1 percent below last month to 4,578 million pounds, but they stand virtually the same as a year ago.

Meat Products

Frozen and chilled beef totaled 361 million pounds, 1 percent above last month and 29 percent above a year ago. Total pork stocks increased 4 percent in April to 252 million pounds. However, this level is 36 percent below a year earlier. Pork belly holdings totaled 52 million pounds, 13 percent above last month but 60 percent below 1972.

Poultry and Eggs

Frozen chickens totaled 86 million pounds, down 1 percent from last month and 24 percent less than a year ago. Frozen turkeys dropped 26 million pounds during April to 90 million pounds. Stocks at this level are 22 percent below last month and 26 percent below a year earlier. Whole turkeys dropped 28 percent during April and other turkeys declined 5 percent. Frozen egg stocks declined 3 percent during April to 48 million pounds.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks reached 125 million pounds, 8 percent above March but 2 percent below last year. Government butter stocks declined 3 percent in April. Natural cheese stocks were 298 million pounds, down 1 percent from last month and 4 percent below a year earlier.

Fruits and Vegetables

Fresh apples continued their seasonal decline with 348 million pounds left in storage on April 30. This level is 38 percent below last month and 27 percent below last year. Stocks of controlled atmosphere apples declined 36 percent during April and regular storage holdings declined 46 percent.

Frozen orange juice concentrate increased seasonally to 81 million gallons, 5 percent above March and 36 percent above last year. Other juice concentrates are up 13 percent from last month to 248 million pounds.

Frozen fruits declined 8 percent during April to 352 million pounds, 12 percent less than a year earlier. Of all frozen fruits, only strawberries showed an increase.

Frozen vegetables weighed 786 million pounds, 7 percent below last month and 5 percent below a year earlier. Most vegetables continue to decline except for spinach and asparagus which have started the new harvest season.

Frozen french fries showed a small decrease during April, with the end of the month stocks totaling 655 million pounds, 12 percent below a year earlier. Other frozen potatoes totaled 90 million pounds, 2 percent below last month and 14 percent below last year.

Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Public warehouses held 3,725 million pounds on April 30, accounting for 61 percent of total stocks. Public warehouses held 840 million pounds of cooler stocks and 2,885 million pounds of freezer stocks.

Cooler space in public warehouses was 53 percent occupied on April 30. This is 1 point below March and 4 points below the 57 percent occupancy a year ago. Cooler occupancy decreased in the East North Central, South Atlantic, East South Central, and Pacific regions. The other regions increased or remained the same.

Freezer space was 61 percent occupied on April 30. This was the same as last month but 4 percentage points below a year ago. Occupancy declined in four regions, increased in three; two were unchanged.
