## Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Cooler held commodities totaled 1,288 million pounds on May 31, down 20 percent from a year earlier. Freezer stocks totaled 4,480 million pounds compared with 4,604 million pounds last year.

## Meat Products

Stored beef on May 31 amounted to 340 million pounds, 23 percent more than a year earlier.

Pork gained 2 percent during May bringing total pork holdings up to 254 million pounds, but they remain about one-third below a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies amounted to 56 million pounds, up 13 percent from a month ago but 58 percent below a year earlier.

## Poultry and Eggs

Frozen poultry stocks totaled 172 million pounds, 20 percent below a year earlier. Chicken, at 83 million pounds, was down 18 percent. Turkey was down 21 percent. Shell egg stocks totaled 47 thousand cases on May 31, about one-fourth of the stocks a year earlier. Although all classes of frozen egg stocks advanced during May and totaled 47 million pounds, by month's end they stood 41 percent lower than on May 31, 1972.

## Dairy Products

Seasonal advances in stocks of cream, butter, and natural cheese were reported during May. Butter stocks advanced to 143 million pounds, 14 percent more than on April 30, but 10 percent below a year ago. The Government-owned 105 million pounds of butter on May 31, compared with 104 million the previous month. Total natural cheese stocks gained 9 percent and by May's end amounted to 332 million pounds, slightly below a year earlier.

### Fruit and Vegetables

Stocks of fresh apples totaled 147 million pounds--about 37 percent below a year earlier. The May decline was 201 million pounds--41 million less than in 1972 and 30 million less than in 1971.

Frozen fruit holdings amounted to 322 million pounds, down 8 percent from a month earlier and 10 percent below a year ago. Stocks of most frozen fruit items declined during May except for frozen strawberries which increased 12 percent to 84 million pounds.

Frozen vegetables amounted to 754 million pounds--down 5 percent from a month earlier. A 40-million-pound disappearance increases in asparagus, broccoli, green peas and spinach.

The 587 million pounds of frozen french fries in storage on May 31 were down 10 percent from a month earlier and 17 percent below a year earlier.

Frozen orange concentrate stocks increased seasonally to 91 million gallons, a gain of 8 million gallons during May. Stocks a year earlier totaled 72 million gallons following a 12 million gallon increase during May.

### Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Public warehouse held 3,431 million pounds on May 31, accounting for 59 percent of the total stocks. Public warehouses held 662 million pounds of cooler stocks and 2,769 million pounds of freezer stocks.

Cooler space in public warehouses was 52 percent occupied on May 31. This is the same occupancy rate as last month but is 5 points below the 57 percent occupancy a year ago.

Freezer space was 59 percent occupied on May 31, compared with 60 percent last month and 65 percent last year.
