Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space on September 30 totaled 2,507 million pounds, 72 percent more than August 31 and 5 percent above a year ago. Seasonal increases in fresh apples and pears accounted for the large increase from last month. Freezer-held stocks increased 7 percent in September to 5,216 million pounds.

Meat Products

Total beef in storage on September 30 totaled 247 million pounds, 3 percent less than last month and 17 percent less than a year earlier. Total pork holdings increased 7 percent in September to 193 million pounds. This is virtually the same as on September 30, 1972. Stocks of frozen pork bellies amounted to 8.5 million pounds -- down 16 percent from last month and only about half as large as last year's stocks.

Poultry and Eggs

Frozen poultry stocks totaled 467 million pounds, 31 percent above last month but 10 percent below a year earlier. Chicken, at 105 million pounds, was up 16 percent from last month and unchanged from a year ago. Turkey stocks were up 36 percent during the month to 357 million pounds. Whole turkeys increased 37 percent during September and turkey parts by 29 percent.

Stocks of frozen eggs on September 30 totaled 50 million pounds, up 1 percent from last month but 40 percent below last year.

Dairy Products

Stocks of cream, butter and natural cheese declined seasonally during September. Butter stocks declined 22 million pounds during the month to 92 million. Government stocks of butter declined 12 million pounds to 61 million. Natural cheese, at 375 million pounds, was down 5 percent from last month and 7 percent from a year earlier.

Fruit and Vegetables

Fresh apples started their seasonal increase during the month and on September 30 totaled 1,200 million pounds, compared with only 16 million pounds last month.

Frozen fruits increased 3 percent during September to 525 million pounds, 2 percent more than a year earlier. All frozen fruits increased except apricots, boysenberries, cherries, red raspberries and strawberries.

Most frozen vegetables increased seasonally during the month and stocks of all vegetables totaled 1,397 million pounds on September 30. Stocks at this level were 21 percent above last month but 2 percent below a year earlier.

Frozen potatoes started their seasonal increase and stocks totaled 307 million pounds, up 25 percent from last month but 36 percent below last year. French fried potatoes amounted to 245 million pounds -- 27 percent more than last month and other frozen potatoes at 62 million pounds were 18 percent above last month.

Frozen orange juice concentrate totaled 95 million gallons on September 30, down 10 percent from last month but 57 percent above a year ago.

Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Public warehouses held 3,948 million pounds on September 30, accounting for 51 percent of the total refrigerated holdings. Of this amount, 594 million pounds were held in coolers and 3,354 million pounds were freezer stocks.

Cooler space in public warehouses was 51 percent occupied on September 30. This is 3 points below August 31 and 5 points below a year ago.

Freezer rooms were filled to 65 percent of capacity, up from 62 percent last month but below the 69 percent reported at this time last year.
