## Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Seasonal declines in fresh fruit helped lower cooler-held stocks on November 30 to 3,972 million pounds, 10 percent below last month but 11 percent above a year ago. Freezer-held stocks dropped 4 percent during November to 5,570 million pounds.

## Meat Products

Beef in storage on November 30 totaled 361 million pounds, 13 percent more than last month and 3 percent more than last year. Total pork stocks jumped 21 percent during November to 271 million pounds. Current holdings were up 12 percent from a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies more than doubled during November. Stocks on hand November 30 were 35 million pounds compared to 16 million pounds last month and 34 million pounds a year earlier.

## Poultry and Eggs

Frozen chicken stocks amounted to 135 million pounds on November 30, and at this level were 13 percent above last month and 23 percent greater than a year ago. Turkey stocks declined 28 percent during November to 330 million pounds. Whole turkeys amounted to 282 million pounds, down 31 percent from last month.

Frozen egg holdings amounted to 51 million pounds compared with 54 million stored last month and 76 million a year ago.

## Dairy Products

Total butter stocks dropped to 52 million pounds, 23 percent below last month and 61 percent below a year earlier; Government stocks dropped 37 percent during November. Natural cheese stocks dropped 5 percent from last month to 353 million pounds. These stocks were the same as last year.

### Fruit and Vegetables

The November net-disappearance of fresh apples--388 million pounds--left 2,553 million pounds in storage by the end of the month. Apples in regular storage were down to 1,665 million pounds, 21 percent less than October but 22 percent more than a year earlier. Controlled atmosphere (CA) stocks totalled 888 million pounds 5 percent more than a month earlier and 4 percent more than a year earlier.

Frozen fruit stocks declined to 535 million pounds which resulted in a 2 percent decline during November. Stocks were about 1 percent below those of last year. During November stocks of all frozen fruit packs declined except for frozen apples and "other" frozen fruits.

Orange concentrates move into the 1973-74 pack season with a 67 million gallon carryover. November 30 stocks were down 15 percent from last month but 56 percent higher than last year.

Supplies of frozen vegetables were 1,488 million pounds on November 30, down 5 percent from a month earlier but up 2 percent from a year earlier.

Frozen french fries moved up 19 percent during November to total 413 million pounds by the end of the month. However, these stocks were 28 percent below a year ago. Other frozen potatoes totaled 80 million pounds, up 3 percent from last month but down 6 percent from last year.

### Public Warehouse Stocks

Product weight in public cooler rooms totaled 796 million pounds, about 20 percent of the total cooler weight in all refrigerated warehouses. Freezer rooms in public warehouses held 3,583 million pounds or 65 percent of all the product weight in freezer rooms.
