Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Cooler stocks on hand December 31 totaled 3,436 million pounds, 14 percent less than a month earlier but 16 percent above a year ago. The December decline was principally due to the out movement of fresh fruits and vegetables. Freezer stocks were 5,578 million pounds, about the same as the previous month but 12 percent more than a year earlier.

Meat Products

Year end stocks of all beef totaled 431 million pounds, a 10 percent gain over the preceding month and 17 percent more than a year earlier. Total pork in storage moved up to 284 million pounds, 3 percent more than the previous month and 33 percent greater than a year ago.

Holdings of frozen pork bellies totaled 48 million pounds--up 52 percent from the previous month and 23 percent from a year ago.

Poultry and Eggs

A 7-percent decline in poultry stocks during December left 436 million pounds in storage by the end of the year. These stocks were 35 percent greater than a year earlier. Holdings of frozen turkeys were down 12 percent from last month and were at 288 million pounds on December 31. These supplies were 39 percent larger than last year.

Frozen egg holdings declined to 46 million pounds, 6 percent below a month earlier and 33 percent below last year.

Dairy Products

Butter holdings were off 14 percent from a month earlier and totaled 44 million pounds on December 31. These stocks were 59 percent under those of a year earlier. American cheese holdings at 289 million pounds were about the same as last month but were 7 percent larger than last year.

Fruit and Vegetables

Fresh apple stocks declined 18 percent during the past month to 2,076 million pounds but were 19 percent greater than on December 31, 1972.

Stocks of frozen fruit declined 3 percent during December to 517 million pounds. All frozen fruit stocks declined except apples which showed a 35 percent increase.

Frozen orange juice concentrate started a seasonal increase. The stocks totaled 73 million gallons on December 31, 1974, 10 percent above last month and 74 percent above a year ago.

Most frozen vegetables declined seasonally during the month and stocks of all frozen vegetables totaled 1,390 million pounds on December 31. Stocks at this level were 6 percent below last month but 5 percent above a year earlier.

Frozen potatoes continued their seasonal increase and stocks totaled 546 million pounds, up 9 percent from last month but 19 percent below last year. French fries amounted to 451 million pounds, 10 percent more than last month while other frozen potatoes at 95 million pounds were up 8 percent during the month.

Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Public warehouse stocks totaled 4,346 million pounds on December 31. This accounted for 48 percent of the total weight in all refrigerated warehouses. Cooler stocks in public warehouses amounted to 699 million pounds. There were 3,647 million pounds of frozen products in public freezer rooms.

Occupancy of public cooler space was 56 percent at the close of the year, up 2-points from the previous month and unchanged from a year earlier.

Freezer occupancy was 72 percent, a gain of 1-point from a month earlier. Last year at this time public freezer occupancy was 68 percent.
