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Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities held in refrigerated storage on March 31 totaled 8,073 million pounds, 2 percent below last month but 26 percent above a year ago. Cooler rooms held 2,305 million pounds, 11 percent less than last month and freezer rooms held 5,768 million pounds, 2 percent more than last month.

Meat Products

Red meat stored on March 31 totaled 943 million pounds, 9 percent more than a month earlier and 37 percent more than a year earlier. Holdings of beef were up to 476 million pounds, a 6 percent gain over the preceding month and 33 percent more than at this time last year. Pork stocks, at 342 million pounds, were up 11 percent from last month and 43 percent more than last year.

Poultry and Eggs

March 31 poultry stocks amounted to 382 million pounds, down 2 percent from a month earlier but 87 percent above a year earlier. Turkey stocks were down 7 percent from the preceding month and at 225 million pounds were almost double the holdings of a year earlier.

Shell egg stocks advanced 48 percent to 63 thousand cases. This was 35 percent less than last year.

Frozen eggs totaled 40 million pounds, up 12 percent from last month but 18 percent lower than last year.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 56 million pounds, 12 percent more than a month earlier but 52 percent less than last year.

American cheese stocks moved up to 362 million pounds by March 31. This was an 11 percent gain over the previous month and 48 percent above a year earlier.

Fruit and Vegetables

Fresh apple stocks were down to 785 million pounds by March 31, a drop of 32 percent from the month before. Total stocks were 40 percent above a year earlier.

A record March 31 inventory of 105 million gallons of frozen orange juice concentrate was in storage. These stocks were 7 percent larger than last month and 27 percent larger than last year.

Stocks of frozen apples and strawberries increased during March but stocks of other fruit packs declined. By the end of the month total frozen fruit amounted to 450 million pounds, down 4 percent from the previous month but up 15 percent from a year earlier.

Frozen vegetable stocks amounted to 1,058 million pounds. This was 7 percent under a month earlier but 25 percent more than a year ago.

Frozen potato stocks gained 6 percent during March and totaled 695 million pounds on March 31. This was 3 percent less than a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Public warehouses held 4,590 million pounds on March 31, accounting for 57 percent of the total stocks. Public warehouses held 904 million pounds of cooler stocks and 3,686 million pounds of freezer stocks.

Cooler space in public warehouses was 62 percent occupied on March 31. This compares with a 58 percent occupancy rate last month and 54 percent a year ago.

Freezer space in public warehouses was 67 percent occupied on March 31. This is the same as last month but up from last year's occupancy of 62 percent.
