Cooler and Freezer Stocks

May 31 stocks in refrigerated rooms totaled 7,690 million pounds, down 2 percent from last month but 32 percent above last year. Cooler-held stocks at 1,790 million pounds were down 12 percent from the previous month but were 37 percent higher than last year. Freezer-held supplies moved up to 5,900 million pounds, a 1 percent gain since April 30 and 30 percent larger than last year.

Meat Products

Red meats in storage were 1,021 million pounds on May 31, up 1 percent from a month earlier and 46 percent higher than last year. Total beef amounted to 461 million pounds, down 2 percent from a month earlier but 37 percent above a year earlier. Total pork stocks were 3 percent larger than the previous month. The 417 million pounds stored on May 31 was 61 percent higher than last year.

Poultry and Eggs

May 31 supplies of frozen poultry totaled 398 million pounds, 4 percent larger than a month earlier and more than double the stocks of last year. Turkeys gained 1 percent during May and totaled 217 million pounds by the end of the month. This was almost two and one-half times the stocks of a year earlier. Frozen chickens were up 8 percent to 177 million pounds, twice the stocks of May 31, 1973.

Shell egg holdings moved up to 71 thousand cases, about 8 percent more than the preceding month and 82 percent higher than a year earlier.

Frozen egg stocks also gained seasonally. A 12 percent gain since April 30 raised May 31 stocks to 49 million pounds, 10 percent larger than a year earlier.

Dairy Products

Butter holdings totaled 97 million pounds on May 31, a 22 percent advance from a month earlier but 30 percent less than last year.

Net gains in American cheese stocks raised total holdings to 448 million pounds, 9 percent above April 30, 1974 and 65 percent above May 31, 1973.

Stocks of all cheese were 527 million pounds on May 31, an 8 percent increase from a month earlier and 59 percent more than a year ago.

Fruit and Vegetables

Fresh apple holdings were down to 201 million pounds on May 31, 56 percent less than a month earlier but 37 percent larger than last year. About 43 percent more apples were in CA storage on May 31 than a year earlier.

Frozen fruit declined 1 percent during May, leaving 421 million pounds in storage by the end of the month. This was 26 percent larger than last year. All frozen fruit packs declined during May except strawberries. They increased 35 percent to 135 million pounds, 38 percent more than a year earlier.

Frozen orange concentrate stocks were at a record 126 million gallons on May 31. The 10-percent gain during May raised stocks 31 percent above last year.

Frozen vegetable holdings declined 6 percent during May to 936 million pounds, but these supplies were 30 percent larger than a year earlier. Broccoli, asparagus, spinach, and southern greens showed strong gains during the month but they were more than offset by declines in other packs.

Frozen potato stocks totaled 659 million pounds, down 9 percent from last month and 2 percent from last year.

Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Product weight in public warehouses totaled 4,814 million pounds, 63 percent of the stocks in all warehouses. Public warehouses held 1,001 million pounds in cooler facilities and 3,813 million pounds in freezer rooms.

Public cooler occupancy declined one-percentage point during May to 64 percent. A year earlier, occupancy was 53 percent.

Freezer occupancy moved up to 70 percent compared with 69 percent last month and 59 percent last year.

Data for this report are collected from refrigerated storages, public and private, where food products are normally stored for 30 days or more. Stocks in space owned or leased by the Armed Forces are not reported. Food stocks held under bond are included in the storage data.
