## Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Seasonal declines in fresh apples, fresh vegetables, and nuts lowered stocks of cooler-held commodities. On June 30, stocks in cooler rooms totaled 1,657 million pounds--down 9 percent from a month ago but 34 percent above a year earlier. Freezer-held stocks were virtually unchanged from last month but were 26 percent above a year earlier.

## Meat Products

Stocks of red meat declined 9 percent during the month to 924 million pounds. However, these stocks were 37 percent larger than a year ago. Total beef amounted to 443 million pounds, down 5 percent from last month but 37 percent more than a year ago. Total pork holdings declined 14 percent in June to 356 million pounds and at this level are 41 percent larger than a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies dropped 21 percent in June to 69 million pounds but were 41 percent larger than last year.

## Poultry and Eggs

Frozen poultry stocks totaled 449 million pounds, 11 percent above last month and nearly twice as large as a year ago. Chicken, at 181 million pounds, was up 4 percent from last month and more than double the stocks of June 30, 1973. Turkey holdings reached a record June 30 high of 263 million pounds, 16 percent above last month and 91 percent larger than a year ago.

Shell egg stocks declined 6 percent in June to 81 thousands cases. This was 11 percent larger than a year earlier.

Frozen eggs advanced 12 percent during the month to 55 million pounds, 21 percent larger than last year.

## Dairy Products

Butter totaled 120 million pounds on June 30, 23 percent above last month but 20 percent below last year.

Total American cheese stocks moved up to 479 million pounds on June 30. This is 6 percent above last month and 56 percent above a year earlier.

### Fruit and Vegetables

Stocks of fresh apples continued their seasonal decline. On June 30, stocks totaled 67 million pounds--about one-third of the previous month but 46 percent above a year ago.

Frozen fruit holdings increased 7 percent in June to 460 million pounds, 13 percent above a year ago. A large seasonal increase in frozen strawberries more than offset declines in most other frozen fruits.

Frozen orange juice concentrate continued its seasonal increase and totaled 135 million gallons on June 30. This was 7 percent above last month and 19 percent above a year ago.

Frozen vegetables increased 2 percent in June to 982 million pounds, 34 percent above a year earlier. Green peas rose 67 million pounds to 132 million, accounting for most of the increase in frozen vegetables.

Frozen potatoes continued to decline seasonally and stocks totaled 536 million pounds on June 30. These stocks are 16 percent below last month but 5 percent larger than last year's inventory.

### Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Stocks in public warehouses were 4,778 million pounds on June 30, accounting for 63 percent of the total refrigerated stocks. The public warehouses held 998 million pounds of cooler stocks and 3,780 million pounds of freezer stocks.

Cooler space in public warehouses was 64 percent occupied on June 30 compared to 53 percent on the same date a year ago. Freezer space was 69 percent occupied compared to 61 percent a year ago.

Data for this report are collected from refrigerated storages, public or private where food products are normally stored for 30 days or more. Stocks in space owned or leased by the Armed Forces are not reported. Food stocks held under bond are included in the storage data.
