Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Seasonal gains in stocks of fresh fruit, fresh vegetables and shell eggs raised September 30 cooler-held stocks to 2,802 million pounds. This was 68 percent more than on August 31 and 2 percent greater than last year. Stocks in freezer rooms were up to 6,272 million pounds, a 4 percent gain over the previous month and a 20 percent gain over the previous year. Much of this increase is the result of seasonal increases in stocks of frozen vegetables and frozen poultry.

Meat Products

Red meat stocks dropped 3 percent during September to 702 million pounds in storage at the end of the month. These supplies were 34 percent larger than last year. Beef holdings at 356 million pounds were down 5 percent from a month earlier but 46 percent above last year. Total pork in storage amounted to 249 million pounds, a 2 percent decline from a month earlier but 27 percent more than last year.

Poultry and Eggs

Poultry continued the seasonal increases and by September 30 stocks totaled 718 million pounds, up 16 percent from a month earlier and 56 percent more than last year. Turkey supplies, at 526 million pounds, were 22 percent larger than the previous month and 50 percent larger than a year ago.

Shell egg holdings totaled 83 thousand cases, up 28 percent from last month but 3 percent below last year.

Frozen egg stocks were 65 million pounds on September 30, up 1 percent from a month earlier and 23 percent above last year.

Dairy Products

September 30 stocks of butter were 108 million pounds, a 12 percent decline from a month earlier. These stocks were 14 percent larger than a year earlier. Government-owned butter also fell off during September and by the end of the month totaled 24 million pounds, down 61 percent from last year.

American cheese holdings were 465 million pounds, 3 percent under the previous month but 50 percent above a year earlier.

Fruit and Vegetables

With the start of the storage season, stocks of fresh apples moved up to 1,039 million pounds, but were 24 percent below holdings of a year earlier. Fresh pears totaled 320 million pounds, down 5 percent from last year.

Frozen fruit stocks on September 30 showed a 3 percent gain over the previous month. This increase raised total holdings to 612 million pounds which was 18 percent greater than the previous year. Much of the gain was attributable to seasonal increases in stocks of blackberries, blueberries, grapes, peaches, and miscellaneous frozen fruit.

Orange concentrate holdings were 95 million gallons on September 30, down 12 percent from a month earlier but 5 percent above a year ago.

Most frozen vegetable packs increased during September and by the end of the month total vegetable stocks were 1,614 million pounds. This was 18 percent more than the previous month and 15 percent more than last year.

Holdings of frozen potatoes, at 457 million pounds, were up 26 percent since August 31 and 47 percent above last year.

Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Product weight in public refrigerated warehouses totaled 5,054 million pounds or 56 percent of the total weight of all refrigerated stocks. Public warehouses held 907 million pounds of cooler commodities and 4,147 million pounds of freezer products.

Public cooler occupancy was 63 percent, unchanged from a month earlier but 13 points higher than last year.

Freezer occupancy, at 72 percent, was up 3 points from a month earlier and 5 points above a year earlier.

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Data for this report are collected from refrigerated storages, public or private, where food products are normally stored for 30 days or more. Stocks in space owned or leased by the Armed Forces are not reported. Food stocks held under bond are included in the storage data.
