## Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Total weight of commodities in refrigerated warehouses was 8,792 million pounds on February 28, down 6 percent from the previous month but 7 percent more than last year. Cooler-held products totaled 2,874 million pounds, 14 percent less than a month earlier but 11 percent more than this time last year. Freezer-held stocks at 5,918 million pounds were down 1 percent from last month but 5 percent above last year.

## Meat Products

Red meat stocks declined 3 percent during February to 792 million pounds. These supplies were 10 percent under last year's total. All beef in storage moved down to 390 million pounds. This was 6 percent below the previous month's total and 14 percent below last year. Total pork was up 1-percent and raised supplies to 299 million pounds but these stocks were 4 percent under the previous year. Frozen hams increased 30 percent from the previous month to 36 million pounds but were 9 percent under last year. Pork bellies, at 44 million pounds, were 5 percent more than last month but 18 percent less than last year.

## Poultry and Eggs

February 28 stocks of frozen poultry were down to 409 million pounds. This was 7 percent less than last month but 4 percent more than last year. Turkeys in storage on February 28 declined to 240 million pounds, a 10-percent drop for the month. These stocks were 4 percent below last year.

## Dairy Products

February 28 stocks of butter amounted to 59 million pounds, a gain of 9 percent from a month earlier and 17 percent above a year earlier.

Total American cheese stocks at 390 million pounds were 6 percent below the previous month but 19 percent above last year.

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### Fruit and Vegetables

Fresh apples continued their seasonal decline and stocks were at 1,215 million pounds on February 28, 6 percent larger than last year.

A sharp seasonal gain raised frozen orange juice concentrate supplies to 96 million gallons on February 28. This is 19 percent more than last month and 3 percent larger than last year.

With the exception of frozen apples, all frozen fruit stocks were lowered during February. At the end of the month, frozen fruit stocks were 506 million pounds, 10 percent smaller than a month earlier but 6 percent larger than last year.

Frozen vegetable holdings declined seasonally and totaled 1,322 million pounds. The February decline was 11 percent and current holdings are 16 percent more than a year earlier.

Total frozen potatoes moved up 10 percent in February to total 798 million pounds. This is 13 percent larger than last year's supplies.

### Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Stocks in public refrigerated warehouses totaled 4,713 million pounds, accounting for 54 percent of the total refrigerated stocks. The public warehouses held 959 million pounds of cooler commodities and 3,754 million pounds of freezer products.

Public cooler occupancy was 59 percent on February 28 compared with 60 percent a month ago and 59 percent a year earlier.

Freezer occupancy was 67 percent, down from 69 percent a month earlier. Last year at this time freezer occupancy was 68 percent.

Data for this report are collected from refrigerated storages, public or private, where food products are normally stored for 30 days or more. Stocks in space owned or leased by the Armed Forces are not reported. Food stocks held under bond are included in the storage data.
