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## Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Refrigerated holdings totaled 7,693 million pounds on April 30, down 5 percent from the month before and 2 percent from a year earlier. The 2,008 million pounds in cooler rooms were 16 percent smaller than the previous month and 1 percent under last year. Freezer-held stocks amounted to 5,685 million pounds, down 1 percent from a month earlier and 3 percent from a year earlier.

## Meat Products

April 30 red meat stocks were up 1 percent from the previous month. The 794 million pounds in storage were down 20 percent from last year.

Beef holdings were down to 350 million pounds on April 30. These supplies were 9 percent below the previous month and 25 percent under last year.

Stocks of both freezer and cooler pork advanced during April. By the end of the month frozen pork totaled 328 million pounds, 15 percent more than on March 31 but 14 percent under April 30, 1974. Frozen pork bellies amounted to 67 million pounds, a 28 percent gain over a month earlier but 15 percent below a year earlier.

Cooler pork totaled 13 million pounds on April 30, up 3 percent from the month before but 15 percent below last year's total.

## Poultry and Eggs

Frozen poultry stored on April 30 was 342 million pounds. This was 8 percent less than the previous month and 12 percent less than last year. Turkeys on April 30 were down to 180 million pounds, 13 percent below last month and 20 percent below last year.

Frozen eggs declined to 44 million pounds. This was 7 percent below last month's inventory and about the same as last year.

### Dairy Products

April 30 supplies of butter were 64 million pounds, up 5 percent from a month earlier but 19 percent below last year. Total American cheese stocks were down to 381 million pounds, 1 percent below last month and 8 percent below last year.

### Fruit, Juice, and Vegetables

Fresh apple holdings were 435 million pounds, down 43 percent from a month earlier and 4 percent from a year earlier.

Frozen fruit supplies were down 9 percent from a month earlier. The 438 million pounds stored on April 30 were 3 percent larger than last year.

Frozen juices advanced seasonally. The 1,294 million pound inventory, made up of 1,017 million pounds of orange juice and 277 million pounds of other juices, was 3 percent higher than the previous month but 5 percent lower than last year.

*Frozen vegetable holdings declined to 1,128 million pounds. These stocks were 7 percent under a month earlier but 13 percent above a year earlier.*

Frozen potato products moved up to 892 million pounds. These stocks were 10 percent larger than a month earlier and 20 percent higher than at this time last year.

### Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Stocks in public warehouses totaled 4,463 million pounds on April 30. This was 58 percent of the weight in all refrigerated warehouses. Cooler-held stocks in public space were 885 million pounds and freezer stocks were 3,578 million pounds.

Occupancy of public cooler space was 58 percent on April 30, unchanged from a month earlier. This time last year, 65 percent of the space was utilized.

Freezer occupancy dropped one-point to 64 percent. A year earlier it was 69 percent.

*Data for this report are collected from refrigerated storages, public or private, where food products are normally stored for 30 days or more. Stocks in space owned or leased by the Armed Forces are not reported. Food stocks held under bond are included in the storage data.*
