## Cooler and Freezer Stocks

May 31 stocks in refrigerated storages totaled 7,450 million pounds, down 3 percent from a month earlier and 4 percent below May 1974. The 1,680 million pounds in cooler rooms were down sharply from last month-17 percent, and 8 percent below last year. Freezer-held stocks amounted to 5,770 million pounds, up 1 percent from last month but 3 percent below last year.

## Meat and Meat Products

Red meat stocks declined 9 percent during May to 720 million pounds. This was 29 percent less than last year.

Total beef supplies were down to 307 million pounds after a 12 percent reduction during May. These stocks were about two-thirds those of last year.

Pork holdings dropped 6 percent to 324 million pounds. Much of this drop was in frozen pork stocks which totaled 311 million pounds, 6 percent below last month and 22 percent below last year.

## Poultry and Eggs

May 31 stocks of frozen poultry were down to 311 million pounds, about 8 percent less than the month before and 23 percent smaller than last year. Frozen turkeys totaled 159 million pounds, down 11 percent from a month earlier and 30 percent below last year.

Frozen eggs on May 31 were at 45 million pounds, up 3 percent from a month earlier but 10 percent below last year.

Shell egg stocks moved up to 54 thousand cases, more than double the stocks of the month before but down 37 percent from last year.

## Dairy Products

Supplies of butter moved sharply upward during May to total 85 million pounds by the end of the month. These stocks were 28 percent larger than the previous month but 13 percent smaller than last year.

American cheese holdings, at 383 million pounds, were 1 percent larger than last month but 16 percent below last year.

Fruit, Juice, and Vegetables

Fresh apples in storage on May 31 amounted to 184 million pounds. Controlled atmosphere stocks, at 171 million pounds, were down 53 percent from last month but 17 percent above last year.

Frozen fruit holdings dropped 10 percent during May leaving 398 million pounds in storage by the end of the month. This was 8 percent below a year ago.

Orange concentrate holdings moved up to 123 million gallons, 20 percent more than the previous month but about the same as a year earlier.

May 31 stocks of frozen vegetables, down 7 percent from a month earlier, totaled 1,057 million pounds. This was 9 percent more than last year.

Frozen potatoes moved up sharply with a 5 percent gain reported during May. By the end of the month total frozen potato stocks were 946 million pounds, about 45 percent more than last year.

Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Public warehouse stocks amounted to 4,391 million pounds on May 31, or 59 percent of the total refrigerated weight. Cooler-held products in public warehouses totaled 831 million pounds and freezer-held stocks totaled 3,560 million pounds.

Public cooler occupancy at 58 percent was unchanged from the month before but was 6 points below last year.

Freezer occupancy dropped one point to 63 percent, and down 6 points from last year.

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Data for this report are collected from refrigerated storages, public or private, where food products are normally stored for 30 days or more. Stocks in space owned or leased by the Armed Forces are not reported. Food stocks held under bond are included in the storage data.
