## Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks in refrigerated storage totaled 10,557 million pounds on November 30, down 6 percent from the previous month and 1 percent below November 1974. Cooler-held products totaled 4,757 million pounds, 8 percent less than the end of October but 7 percent greater than November last year. Freezer-held stocks decreased 4 percent from last month. Freezer product weight amounted to 5,800 million pounds, down 6 percent from one year ago.

## Meat and Meat Products

November 30 red meat stocks amounted to 657 million pounds, up 15 percent from October 31 but 13 percent lower than at this time a year ago.

Beef in storage on November 30 totaled 317 million pounds, 16 percent more than last month but 12 percent below the November 1974 stocks.

Total pork stocks increased 17 percent during the month to 261 million pounds. This was 14 percent less than a year ago. Frozen pork bellies increased 87 percent from last month, frozen loins increased 77 percent but stocks of frozen hams and canned hams declined seasonally.

## Poultry and Eggs

Frozen chicken stocks were 113 million pounds at the end of November, and at this level were 7 percent below last month and 36 percent below a year earlier. Turkey stocks declined 37 percent during the month to 303 million pounds. This was a 19-percent decrease from November 1974.

Frozen egg holdings amounted to 43 million pounds compared with 47 million last month and 60 million a year ago.

## Dairy Products

Butter stocks remain at record lows. Stocks totaled 16 million pounds on November 30, the smallest quantity on hand for the date since records began in 1916. It was also the lowest for any month since April 1952. Cheddar cheese stocks were 321 million pounds on November 30, down 2 percent from last month and 26 percent below the November 1974 holdings.

Fruit, Juice and Vegetables

Fresh apple stocks declined seasonally to 3,114 million pounds on November 30, down 10 percent from the previous month but 16 percent above the previous year. Controlled atmosphere stocks, at 1,290 million pounds, were up 4 percent from a month ago and 22 percent from one year ago.

Frozen fruit stocks declined to 594 million pounds which was 5 percent below October 31 stocks and 9 percent less than at this time last year.

Orange concentrate moved into the 1975-76 pack season with a 63 million gallon carry over. These November 30 stocks were down 9 percent from last month but 2 percent higher than last year.

Supplies of frozen vegetables were 1,824 million pounds, down 3 percent from October but 4 percent above November 1974.

Frozen french fries were up 7 percent during November to total 578 million pounds by the end of the month. These holdings were 3 percent more than a year ago.

Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Product weight in public refrigerated warehouses totaled 4,615 million pounds on November 30, accounting for 44 percent of the total refrigerated stocks. Public warehouses held 862 million pounds of cooler commodities and 3,753 million pounds of freezer products.

Public cooler occupancy was 56 percent on November 30 compared with 57 percent a month ago and 63 percent a year earlier. Freezer occupancy was 65 percent, down 3 points from a month earlier. Last year at this time freezer occupancy was 72 percent.

Data for this report are collected from refrigerated storages, public or private, where food products are normally stored for 30 days or more. Stocks in space owned or leased by the Armed Forces are not reported. Food stocks held under bond are included in the storage data.
