Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks in refrigerated storage totaled 9.8 billion pounds on December 31, down 7 percent from the previous month and 2 percent below December 1974. Cooler-held products totaled 4.1 billion pounds, 13 percent less than the end of November, but 6 percent above one year ago. Freezer-held stocks decreased 2 percent from last month. Freezer product weight amounted to 5.7 billion pounds, down 7 percent from December 1974.

Meat Products

Red meat in storage moved up to 692 million pounds, a 4-percent gain during December, but year-end stocks were 14 percent less than last year. Total beef, at 358 million pounds, was 12 percent larger than a month earlier but 11 percent below year earlier stocks. December 31 stocks of pork amounted to 256 million pounds, 5 percent below last month and 17 percent below the holdings of one year ago.

Poultry and Eggs

Frozen poultry stored on December 31 totaled 322 million pounds, down 21 percent from a month earlier and 29 percent below last year.

Supplies of turkeys declined to 204 million pounds. These stocks were 29 percent below the previous month and 26 percent below the previous year.

Shell eggs in storage were down to 16 thousand cases, less than half the amount in storage last month. Frozen eggs, at 38 million pounds, were down 11 percent from a month earlier and were less than three-fourths the holdings of December 1974.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 11 million pounds on December 31, the smallest on hand for this date since records began in 1916.

Cheddar cheese, at 308 million pounds, was 4 percent below the previous month and 27 percent below a year earlier.

Fruit, Juice and Vegetables

December disappearance of about 500 million pounds of fresh apples left 2.6 billion pounds in storage on December 31. Of this total, 1.3 billion pounds were in CA rooms, unchanged from a month earlier but 22 percent higher than a year earlier. In regular storage, the 1.3 billion pounds were down 30 percent from November, but 11 percent above last year.

Frozen fruit stocks declined seasonally to slightly over one half billion pounds. December reductions were reported for all items except frozen apples. Total frozen fruit holdings were 9 percent less than the 1974 year-end stocks.

Frozen vegetables totaled 1.7 billion pounds on December 31, down 9 percent from last month but slightly higher than the year before.

Frozen french fries remained unchanged from a month earlier. Year end stocks are 2 percent above year earlier holdings. Other frozen potato stocks advanced 1 percent during the month but were 13 percent less than last year.

Public Warehouse Stocks and Occupancy

Public refrigerated warehouses held 4.4 billion pounds at the end of December, 45 percent of the national total. Cooler commodities in public warehouses totaled 842 million pounds; freezer commodities amounted to almost 3.6 billion pounds.

Public cooler occupancy was 54 percent on December 31, down 2 points from the previous month and down 8 points from a year earlier. Freezer occupancy of 62 percent was 3 points lower than the month before and 8 points below one year ago.

Data for this report are collected from refrigerated storages, public or private, where food products are normally stored for 30 days or more. Stocks in space owned or leased by the Armed Forces are not reported. Food stocks held under bond are included in the storage data.
