COLD STORAGE STOCKS, FEBRUARY 29, 1976

Fresh apples in cold storage remained above the 1974 and 1975 holdings. Larger holdings in Washington State accounted for most of the gain over the earlier years.

Butter stocks increased during February but were the lowest for this time of year since 1952. Cheese in storage is 22 percent below last year.

February 29 stocks of frozen fruits were 13 percent below year-earlier levels. Frozen vegetables showed a slight decrease from 1975 but were 15 percent above February 1974.

Frozen potatoes were 7 percent below last year, but 5 percent above 1974.

Red meat in storage increased slightly from the previous month but February 29 stocks were 15 percent lower than 1975 and 23 percent lower than 1974. Beef is down 7 percent from last year, pork is down 26 percent and canned meats are down 14 percent.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was 54 percent on February 29, down 1 point from the previous month and 5 points from a year earlier. Freezer occupancy of 58 percent was 2-points lower than the month before and 9 points below one year ago.

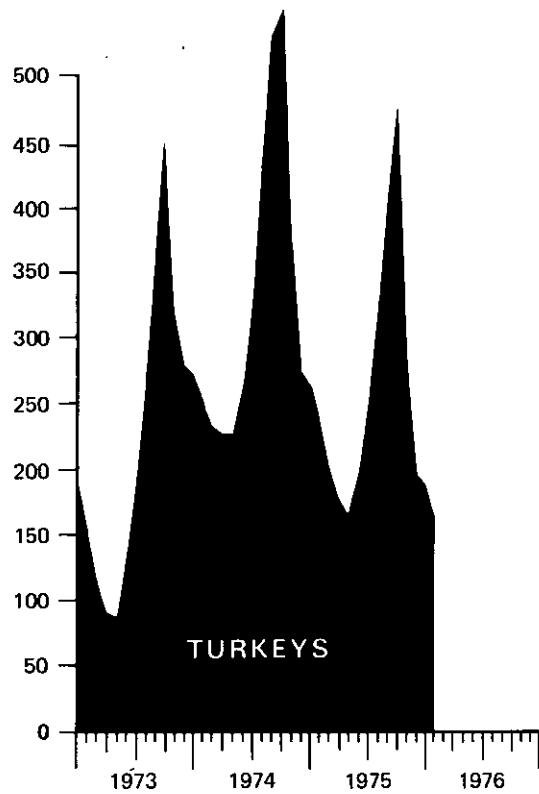
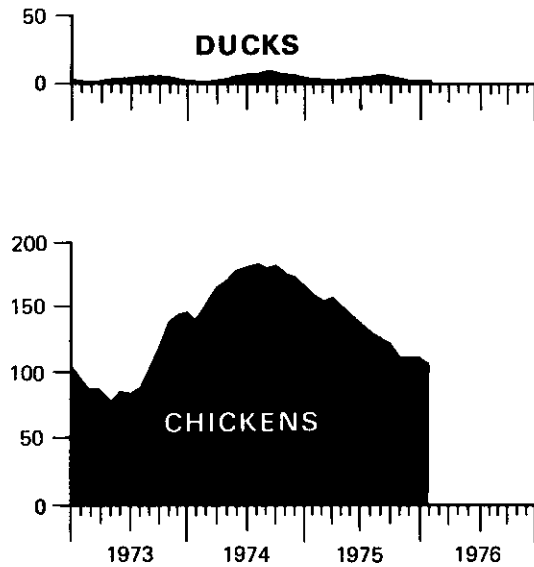
