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## COLD STORAGE STOCKS, SEPTEMBER 30, 1976

Red meat stocks increased five percent during the month and were 26 percent above one year ago. Beef holdings were 53 percent above September 30, 1975 but pork holdings were 3 percent below a year ago.

Butter stocks decreased 17 percent during the month but were 72 percent above a year ago. Cheese holdings were up 1 percent from the previous month and 24 percent from September 1975.

Stocks of frozen fruit were 3 percent above last month but 13 percent less than last year. Stocks of peaches, blueberries, blackberries, and grapes increased during the month but strawberries declined. Frozen fruit juice holdings were up 3 percent from last year but 16 percent below last month.

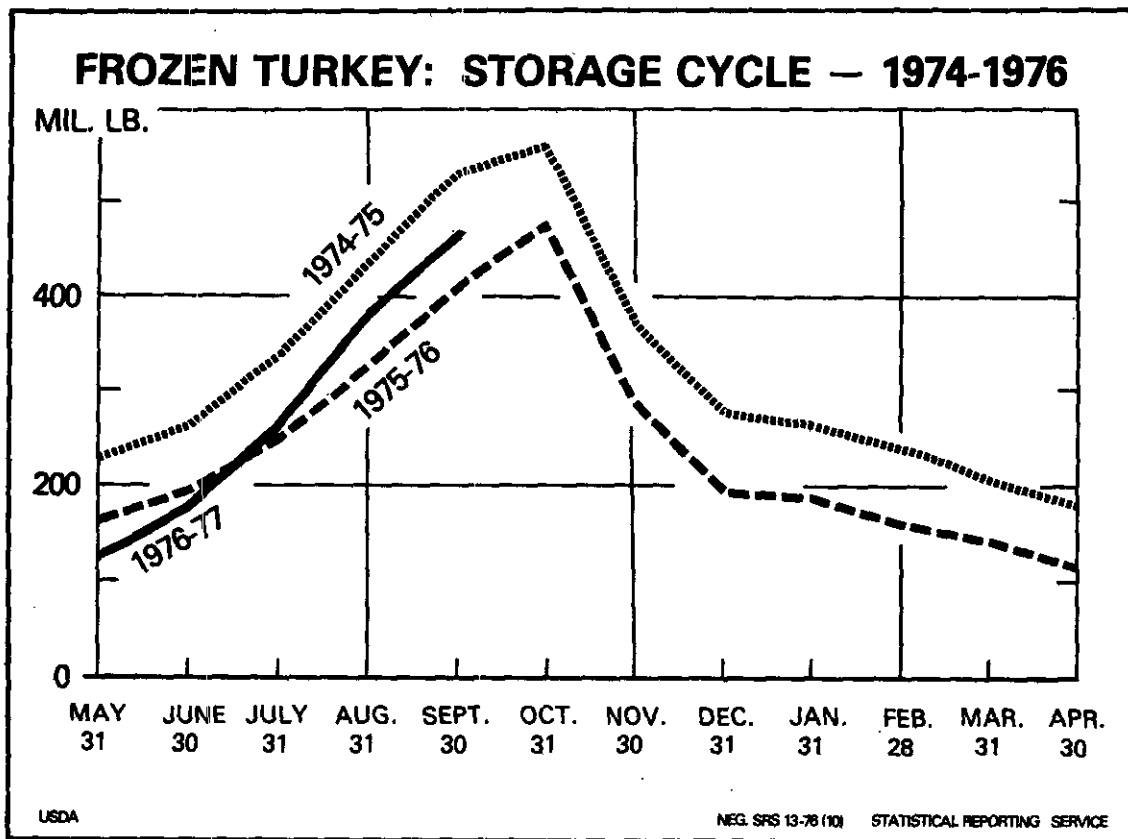
September 30 stocks of frozen vegetables were up 12 percent from last month but 9 percent below last year. Frozen corn increased sharply during the month. Frozen potatoes were 11 percent above last month and 2 percent greater than a year ago.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was 55 percent on September 30, down 1 point from the previous month but 3 points above a year earlier. Freezer occupancy of 68 percent was up 3 points from last month and 2 points above a year ago.

Data for this report are collected from refrigerated storages, public and private, where food products are normally stored for 30 days, or more. Stocks in space owned or leased by the Armed Forces are not reported. Food stocks held under bond are included in the storage data.



#### STORAGE CYCLE OF FROZEN TURKEYS

The storage cycle for frozen turkey usually begins with an upturn during June, peaks around the end of October, and bottoms out around April or May.

The 120 million pounds on May 31 were below the holdings in 1974 and 1975. By July 31, current year's stocks topped year earlier holdings but were one-fifth below 1974. September 30 stocks of 457 million pounds were exceeded only by the September 30, 1974 inventory of 529 million pounds. The record high for any month was 555 million pounds reported on October 31, 1974.
