

# COLD STORAGE

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## COLD STORAGE STOCKS, FEBRUARY 28, 1977

Total red meat stocks were up 1 percent from the previous month and 15 percent greater than last year. Frozen beef is 34 percent greater than last year but frozen pork is 5 percent lower and canned meats 20 percent lower than last year.

Fresh apples in storage were 25 percent less than last month and 14 percent below last year. Frozen apples holdings were 8 percent greater than last month and 21 percent greater than last year.

Butter stocks continue to increase sharply, showing a 50 percent increase during February. Stocks are 6 times greater than last year. Cheese holdings were down 4 percent during the month but remain 29 percent greater than last year.

Frozen potato holdings were 4 percent greater than last month and 9 percent greater than last year. Frozen vegetables stocks were off 16 percent during the month and 20 percent below a year ago.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was 59 percent on February 28, unchanged from last month but 4 points above a year earlier. Freezer occupancy, at 63, was down 1 point from last month but 5 points greater than last year.

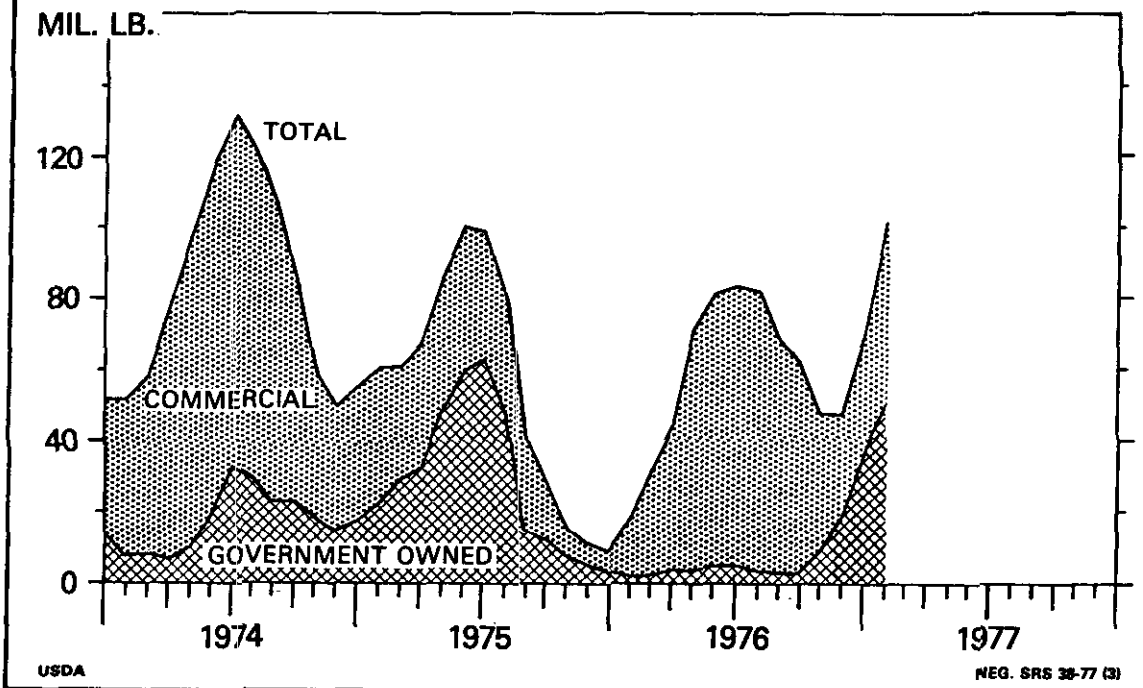
