

COLD STORAGE

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HIGHLIGHTS OF COLD STORAGE STOCKS, APRIL 30, 1977

Total red meat in storage up 5 percent from March, 15 percent above last year.

Frozen beef holdings 25 percent above a year ago and frozen pork up 4 percent. Pork bellies up 31 percent from last month and 15 percent above a year ago.

Butter stocks increased 19 percent during April and are now nearly 3 times greater than a year earlier level.

Cheese holdings 29 percent greater than last year.

Frozen vegetables stocks 23 percent less than last year. Frozen potatoes 13 percent greater.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was 59 percent on April 30, down 1 point from the previous month and 4 points higher than last year. Freezer occupancy of 64 percent was up 2 points from last month and was 6 points higher than last year.

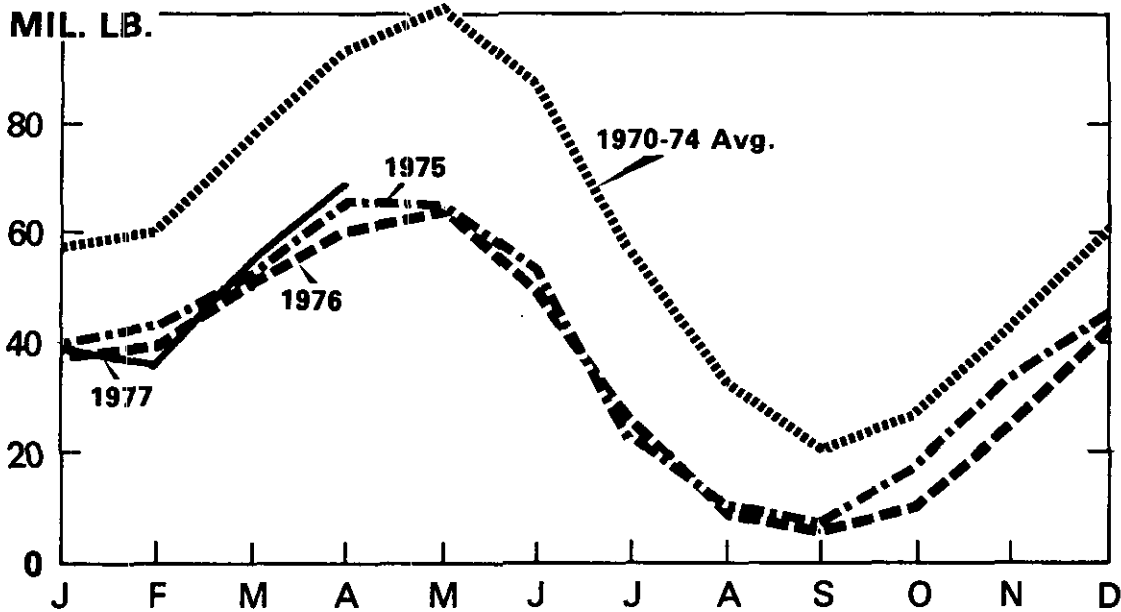
