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## HIGHLIGHTS OF COLD STORAGE STOCKS, MAY 31, 1977

Total red meat in storage is down 3 percent from April but 8 percent greater than last year.

Frozen beef holdings are down 6 percent during the month while pork is up 2 percent. Beef holdings--11 percent greater than last year and pork 5 percent higher. Pork bellies holdings are 17 percent greater than last month and 27 percent above last year.

Butter stocks up 28 percent during the month and nearly 2½ times greater than holdings for 1976.

Natural cheese 28 percent greater than last year.

Frozen vegetable stocks 23 percent below last year. Frozen potatoes 15 percent more than holdings of last year.

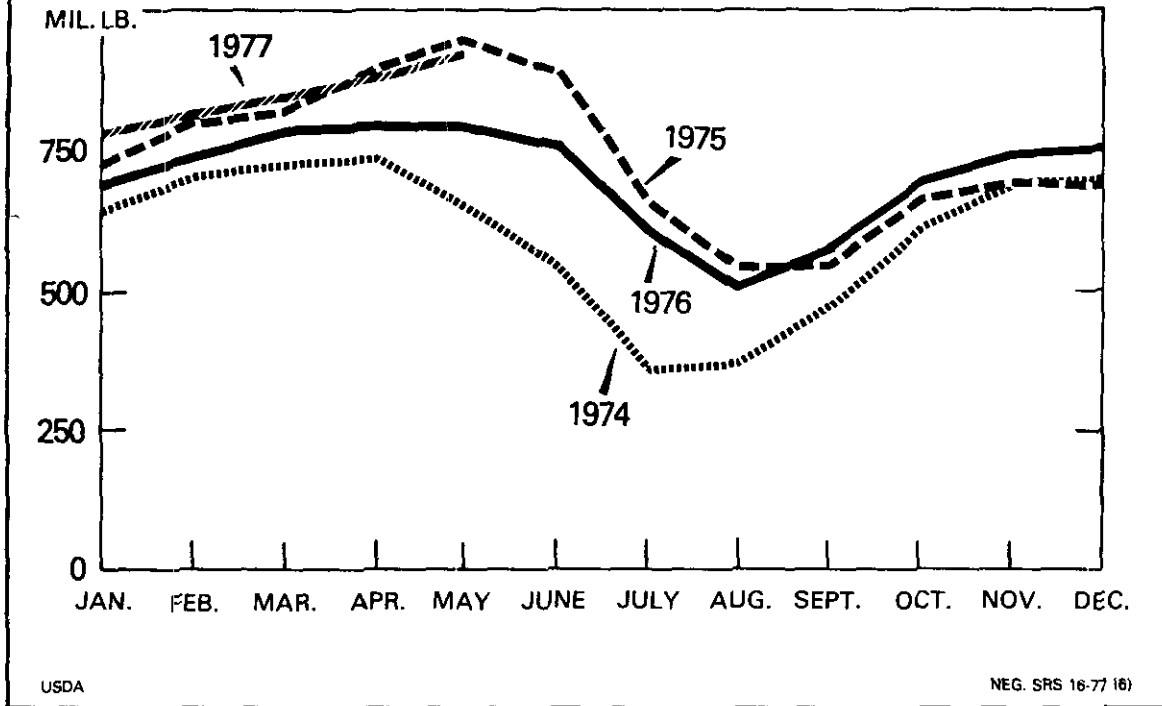
OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was 58 percent on May 31, down 1 point from the previous month but 3 points higher than last year. Freezer occupancy of 64 percent was up 1 point from last month and 6 points higher than last year.
