

COLD STORAGE

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HIGHLIGHTS OF COLD STORAGE STOCKS, JULY 31, 1977

Total red meat in storage is down 12 percent from June and 1 percent lower than last year.

Frozen beef holdings are 5 percent lower than last month but 2 percent higher than a year ago. Pork holdings are 23 percent below last month but only slightly higher than July 1976. Pork bellies are down 53 percent from last month, but are 15 percent greater than last year.

Butter stocks were up 4 percent during the month and almost 2 1/2 times greater than last year's holdings. Cheese holdings are 16 percent above last year.

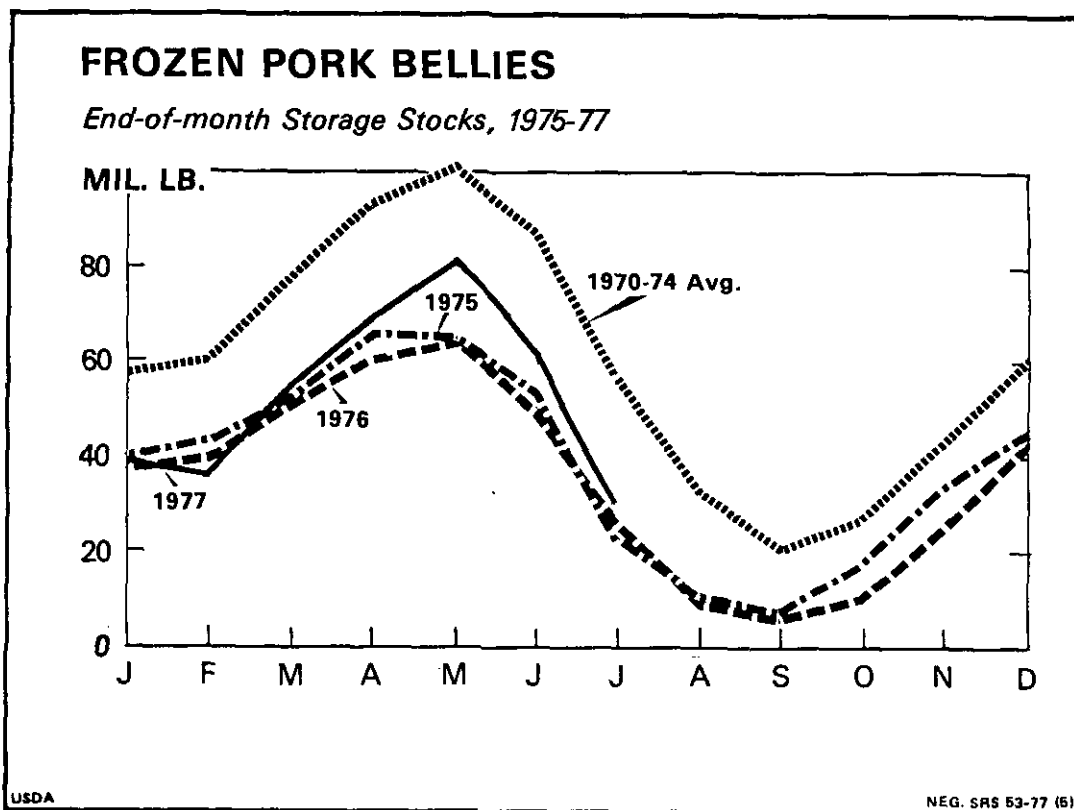
Total frozen fruit holdings increased 27 percent during the month as cherries and red raspberries increased sharply. Frozen vegetable holdings were up 18 percent during the month with sharp increases in green beans and green peas.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was 60 percent on July 31, up 1 point from the previous month and 4 points higher than last year. Freezer occupancy of 67 percent was up 2 points from last month and 4 points higher than last year.
