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HIGHLIGHTS OF COLD STORAGE STOCKS OCTOBER 31, 1977

Butter stocks in cold storage are 3 times 1976 levels and 7 times 1975 holdings. Government owned stocks of both butter and cheese increased dramatically too.

Stocks of frozen fruit, potatoes and other vegetables are running well ahead of last year but meat and poultry are well below a year earlier.

Frozen beef is only 75 percent of a year earlier, but is still 14 percent above October 1975. Pork freezer stocks are at the lowest October levels in over 10 years.

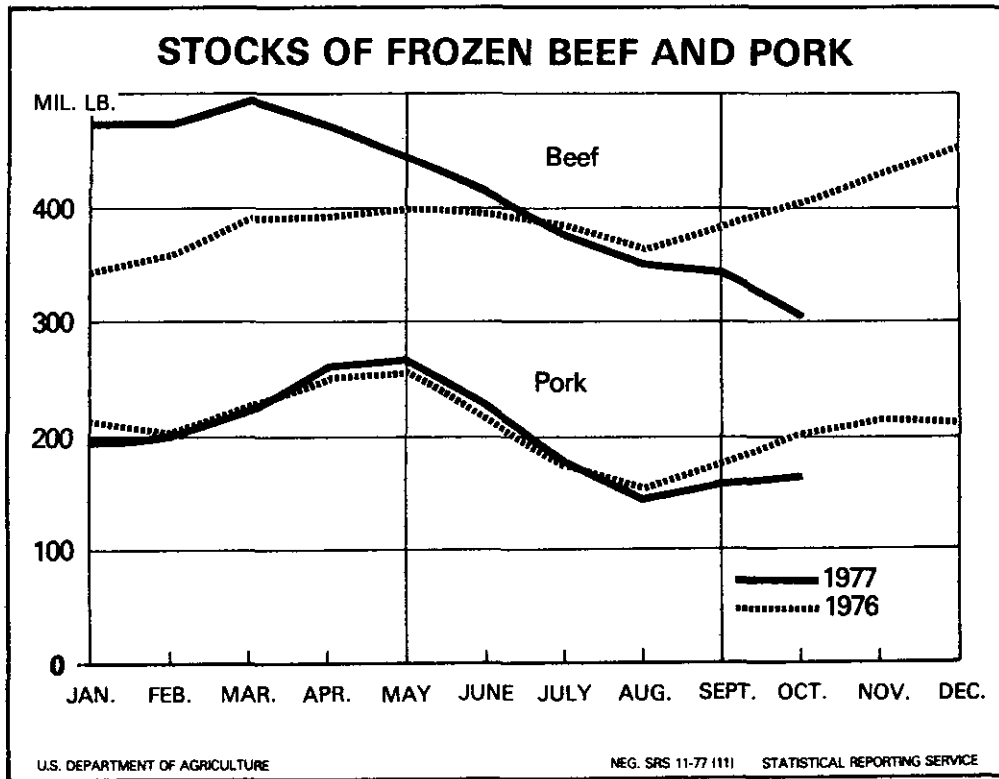
Frozen fruit juices continued to decline seasonally and are at the lowest level in recent years. The seasonal upturn should begin about the first of the year as the Florida citrus crop moves to market.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 59 percent of capacity, up 3 points from last month, and one point above October 1976. Freezer occupancy, at 73 percent of capacity, was one point above last month and last year.
