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HIGHLIGHTS OF COLD STORAGE JANUARY 31, 1978

Total red meat in storage on January 31 was down 3 percent from December 1977 and 26 percent below January 1977.

Frozen beef holdings decreased 2 percent from the previous month and 35 percent from the previous year.

Fresh apples in storage dropped 22 percent from December and 6 percent from last year.

Frozen fruit juice was up 20 percent from the previous month but 19 percent below a year ago.

Butter stocks rose 6 percent from December and were at the highest January level since 1963.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was 55 percent, down 2 points from December. Freezer occupancy at 67 percent was 3 points below December, but 3 points above January 1977.

Beginning with this report, frozen cherries are reported separately as sweet and tart (RSP).

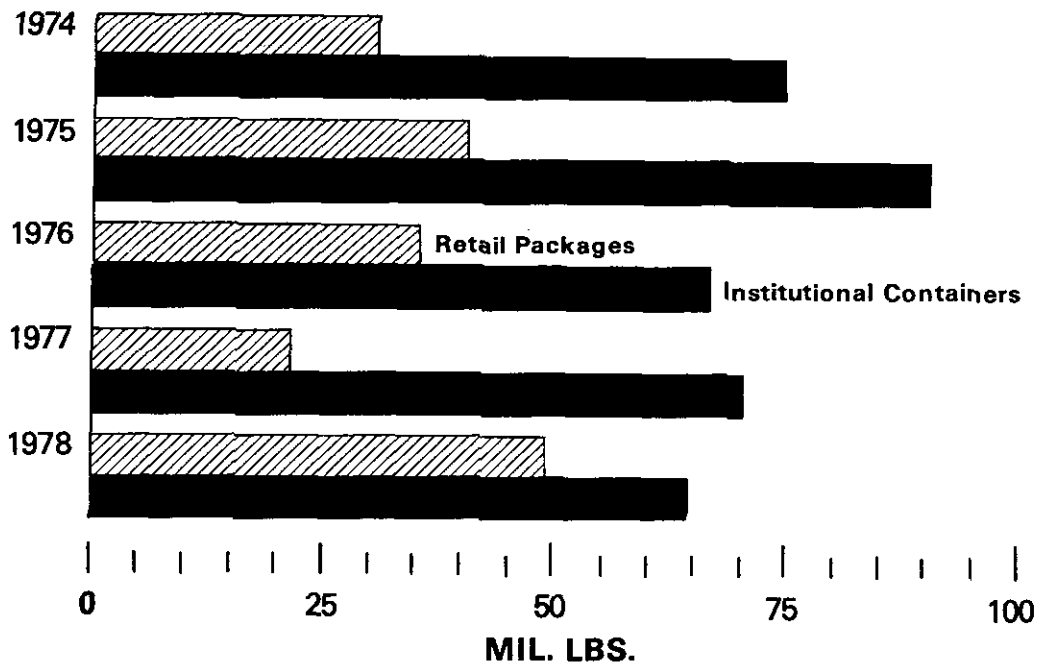
