

# COLD STORAGE

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## HIGHLIGHTS OF COLD STORAGE - APRIL 30, 1978

Total red meat in storage on April 30 was 13 percent above March 1978 but 10 percent below April 1977. Frozen beef holdings increased 4 percent from the previous month but were 22 percent less than the previous year.

Frozen pork holdings were up 28 percent from last month and 5 percent from last year. Pork bellies jumped 79 percent from March and were 2 percent more than the previous year.

Butter stocks rose 3 percent from March and were the largest holdings since August 1971. Natural cheese stocks were up 2 percent from last month but 14 percent below last year.

Frozen vegetable stocks dropped 7 percent from March but were 25 percent above April 1977. Total frozen potatoes were 5 percent more than the previous year.

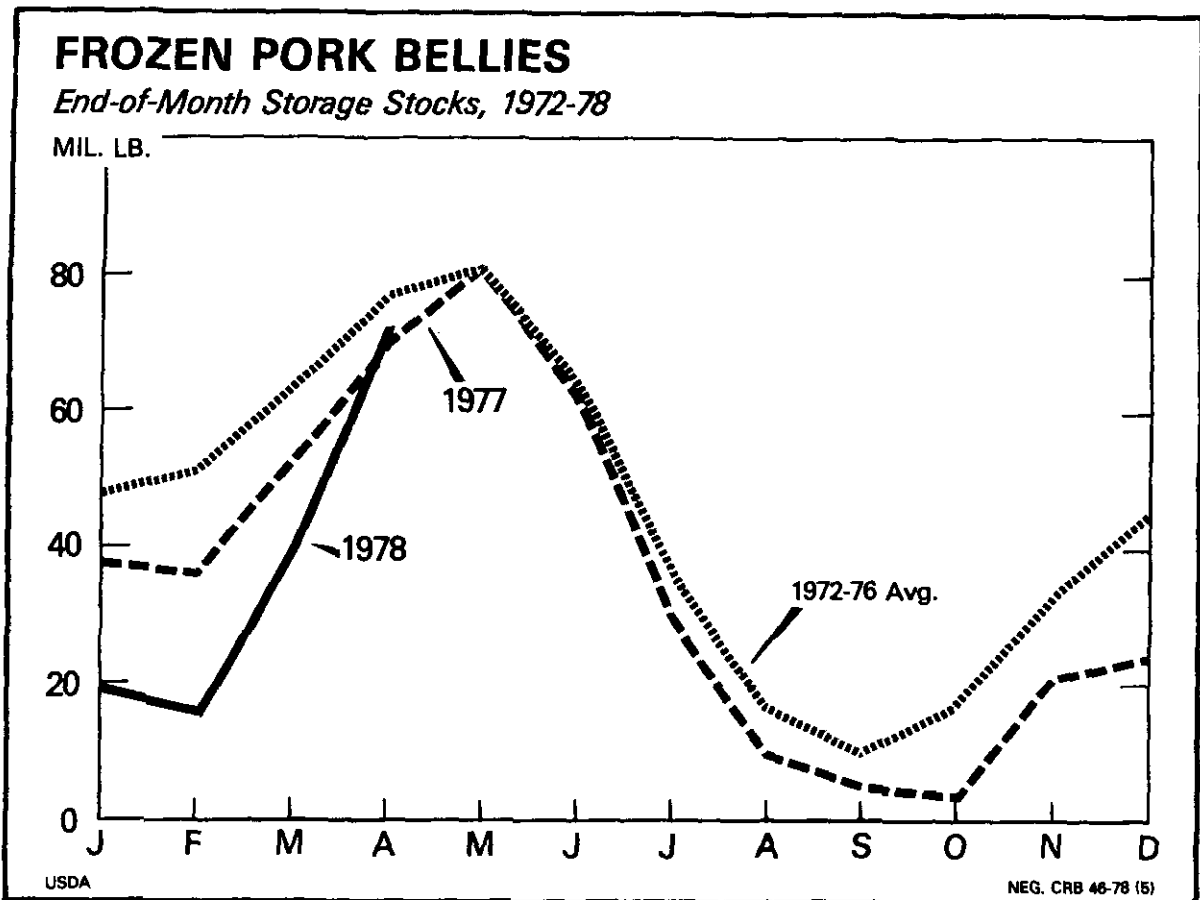
Total fruit juice was 20 percent above the previous month but 14 percent below a year ago.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was 59 percent, unchanged from March. Freezer occupancy at 65 percent was also unchanged from last month, but was 1 point above April 1977.
