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## HIGHLIGHTS OF COLD STORAGE - MAY 31, 1978

Total red meat in storage on May 31 was 2 percent above April 1978 and 5 percent below May 1977. Frozen beef holdings increased 5 percent from the previous month but were 13 percent below the previous year.

Frozen pork holdings were up slightly from last month and 4 percent above last year. Pork bellies increased 16 percent from April and 2 percent over the previous year.

Butter stocks rose 6 percent from April and were the largest since October 1963. Natural cheese stocks were 3 percent larger than last month but 17 percent below last year.

Frozen vegetable stocks dropped 10 percent from April but were 19 percent above May 1977. Total frozen potatoes were 7 percent larger than the previous year.

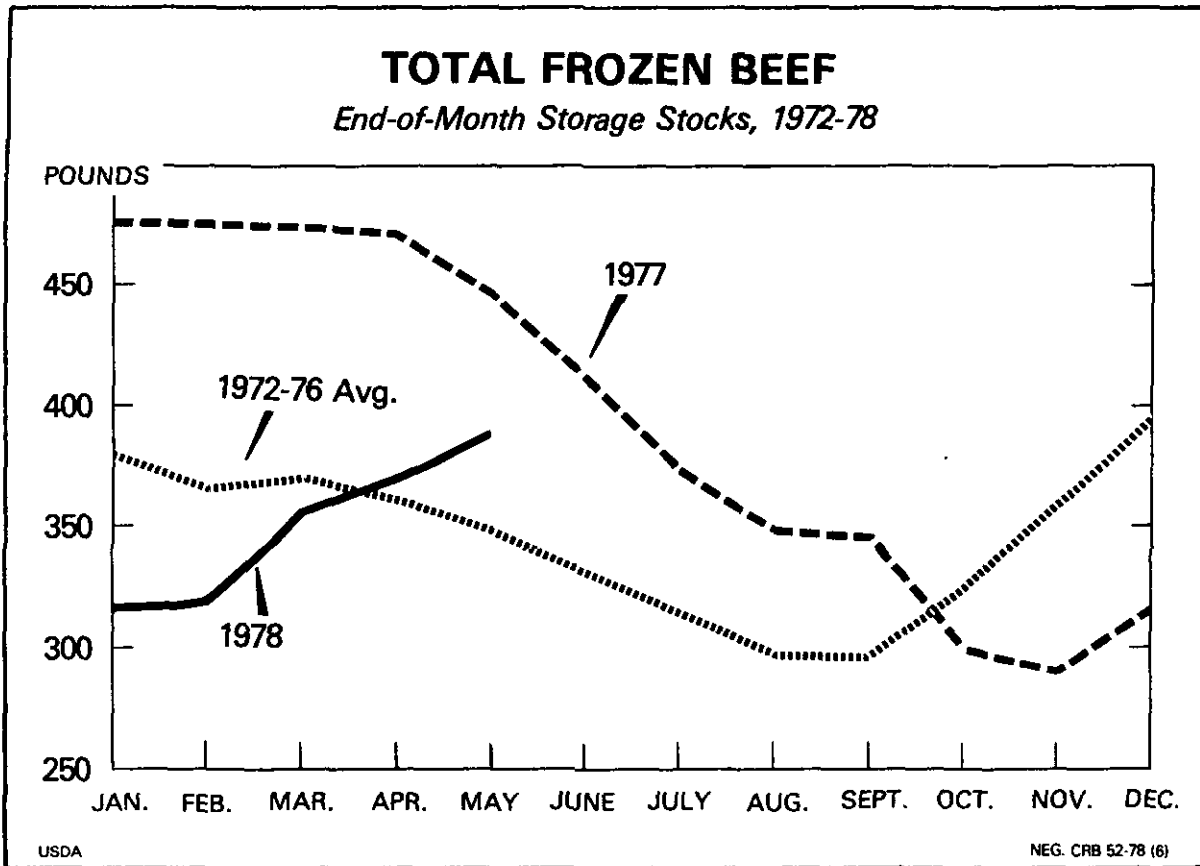
Total frozen fruit juice was 11 percent above the previous month but 13 percent below a year ago.

**OCCUPANCY:** Public cooler occupancy was 59 percent, unchanged from April. Freezer occupancy at 66 percent was also unchanged from last month, but was 2 points above May 1977.
