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HIGHLIGHTS OF COLD STORAGE, JUNE 30, 1978

Total red meat in storage on June 30 was 5 percent below May 31, 1978 and slightly below June 30, 1977. Frozen beef holdings decreased 4 percent from the previous month and 9 percent from the previous year.

Frozen pork holdings declined 8 percent from last month, but were 14 percent above last year. Pork bellies dropped 9 percent from May but were 19 percent over the previous year.

Butter stocks continued upward and were 6 percent above last month. Natural cheese stocks were 9 percent larger than last month but 14 percent below last year.

Frozen vegetable stocks increased 3 percent from May and were 15 percent above June 1977. Total frozen potatoes were 8 percent larger than the previous year.

Total frozen fruit juice was 1 percent above the previous month but 3 percent below a year ago.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was 59 percent, unchanged from May. Freezer occupancy at 66 was also unchanged from last month, but was 1 point above June 1977.

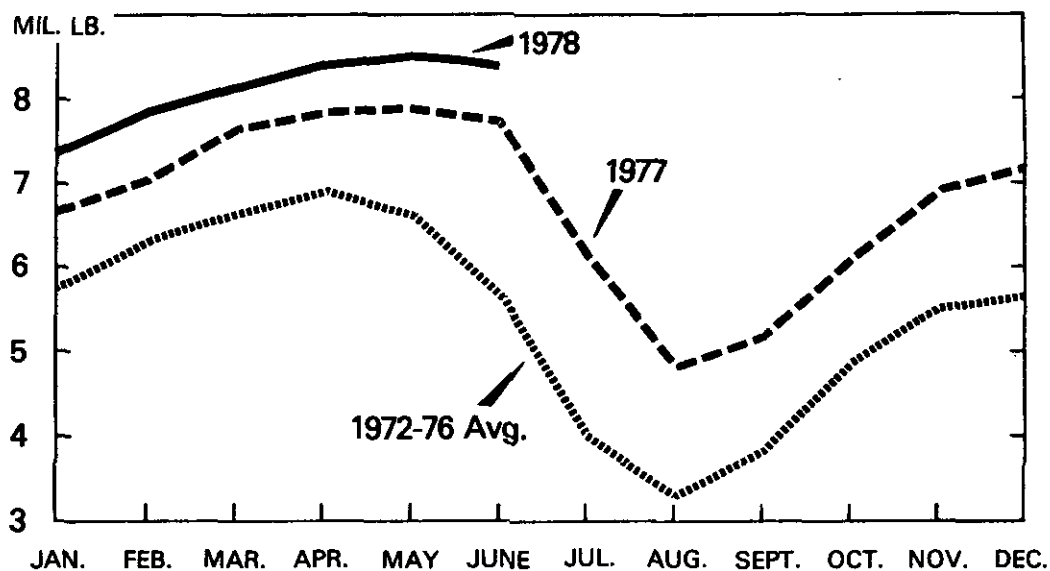
