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HIGHLIGHTS OF COLD STORAGE, SEPTEMBER 30, 1978

Total frozen vegetable and potato stocks are running ahead of 1977 and 1976 seasonal holdings. Frozen vegetables increased 16 percent from last month and 11 percent from last year. Total frozen potatoes were 6 percent above the previous year.

Total frozen poultry was at the lowest September level since 1973. Frozen turkey holdings increased 21 percent over August 31, but were 12 percent below September 30, 1977.

Butter stocks dropped 7 percent from last month but were 30 percent above last year.

Total red meat in storage was 3 percent above the previous month and previous year.

Total pork holdings were off 2 percent from August 31 but were 11 percent above one year ago.

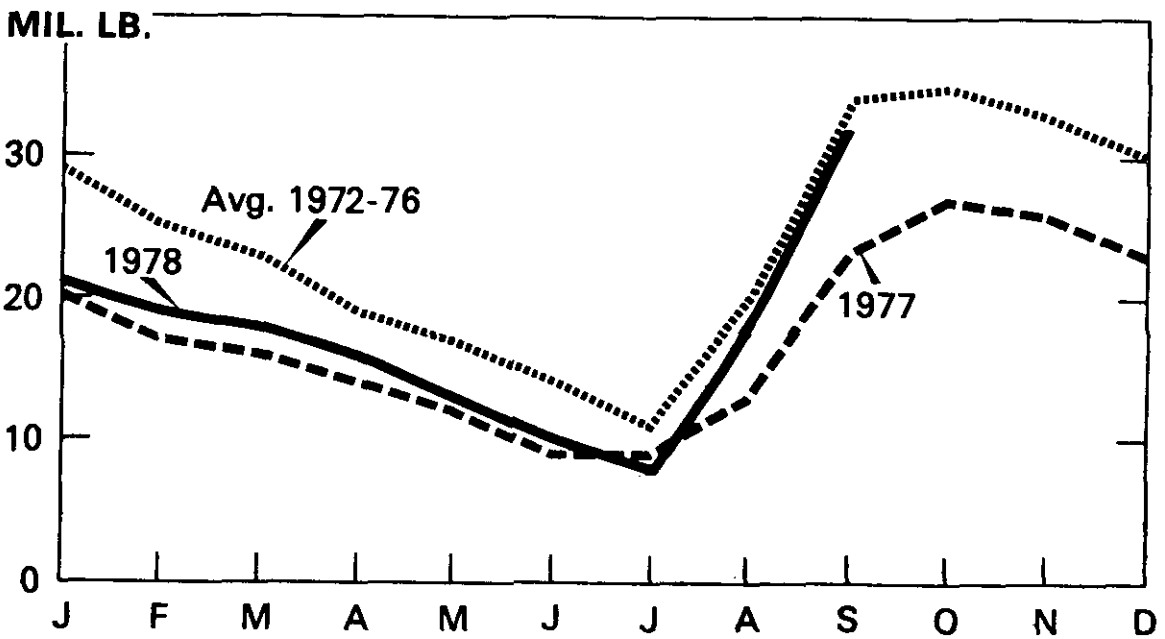
OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was 55 percent, down 2 points from August 31. Freezer occupancy, at 73 percent, was 4 points above last month and 1 point above last year.
