## HIGHLIGHTS OF COLD STORAGE, OCTOBER 31, 1978

Total red meat in storage on October 31 was 6 percent above September 30, 1978 and 19 percent above October 31, 1977. Frozen beef holdings increased 4 percent from last month and 14 percent from the previous year.

Frozen pork holdings were up 17 percent from the previous month, and 24 percent from the previous year. Pork bellies jumped 266 percent from last month and were at the largest October holdings since 1974.

Total frozen poultry stocks were at the lowest October level in 9 years and total turkey stocks were lowest since 1966.

Total apple holdings were 9 percent above last year and 8 percent above 1976.

Frozen fruit juice continued to decline seasonally but was 3 percent above last year.

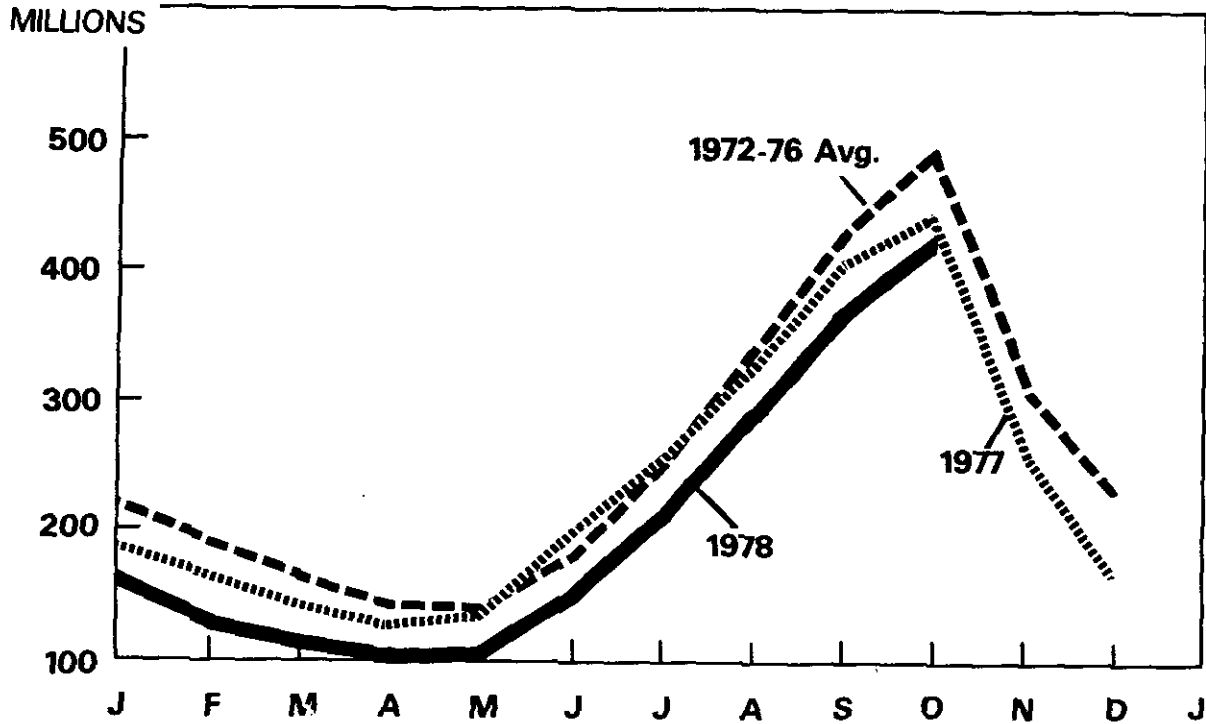
**OCCUPANCY:** Public cooler occupancy was 59 percent, up 4 points from September 30. Freezer occupancy, at 75 percent, was 3 points above last month and 1 point above last year.
