COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JANUARY 31, 1979

Total holdings of frozen red meats, vegetables and fruit juices were above year earlier levels on January 31, 1979 but frozen poultry, eggs, potatoes and fruits were lower.

Total red meat stocks increased slightly during January and were 30 percent above last year. Frozen beef increased 4 percent from the previous month and 34 percent from the previous year.

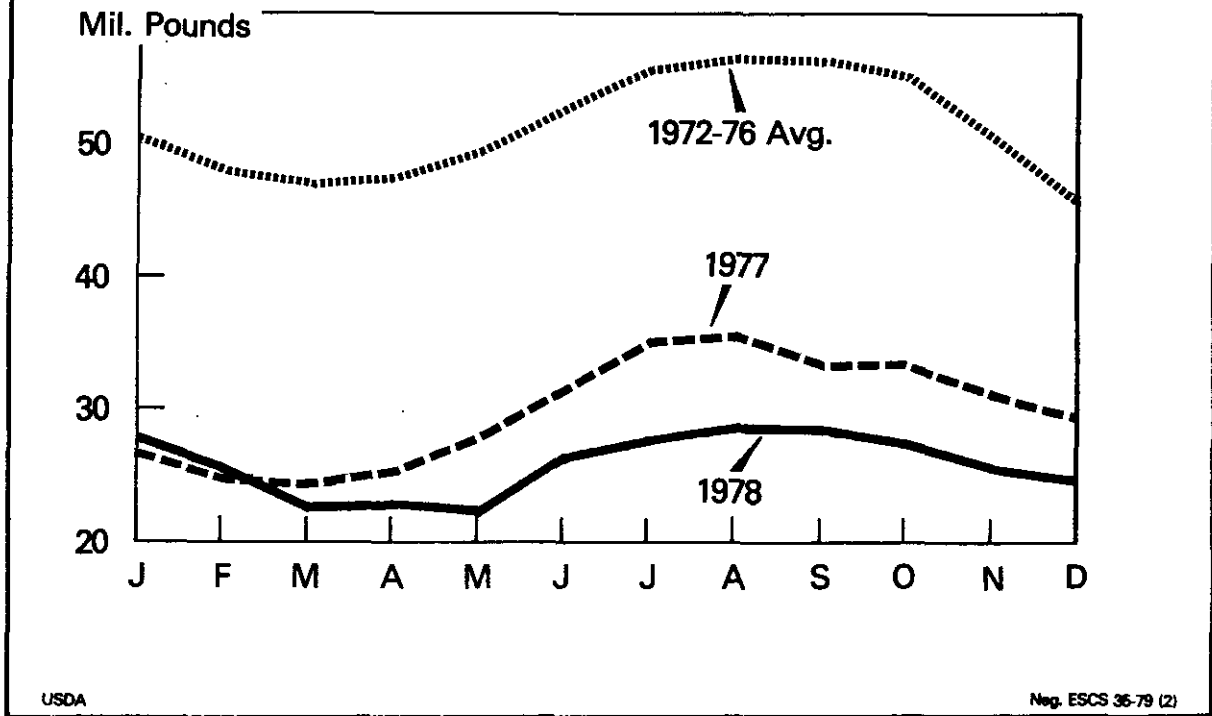
Frozen pork holdings decreased 7 percent from last month but were 28 percent over last year. Pork bellies dropped seasonally but were more than double the 1978 holdings.

Total frozen fruit juices increased seasonally and were more than one-third larger than the previous year's holdings.

Frozen vegetable stocks dropped 13 percent from the previous month but were 7 percent above 1978. Total frozen potatoes declined 1 percent from last month and 11 percent from last year.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was 58 percent, down 2 points from December 31. Freezer occupancy, at 70 percent, was off 2 points from last month, but 2 points above last year.
