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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, FEBRUARY 28, 1979

Stocks of frozen red meats, vegetables and fruit juices were above year earlier levels on February 28, 1979 but frozen poultry, eggs, potatoes and fruits were lower.

Total red meats decreased 2 percent during February but were 26 percent above last year. Frozen beef was 3 percent less than the previous month but 31 percent over 1978.

Frozen poultry dropped 7 percent from last month and was the smallest February holdings since 1973. Total turkeys were down 8 percent from the previous month, but 15 percent above the previous year.

Total frozen fruit juices increased seasonally and were 45 percent above last year and 16 percent above two years ago.

Frozen vegetable stocks dropped 14 percent from the previous month but were 6 percent above 1978. Total frozen potatoes increased 2 percent from last month but were 12 percent below last year.

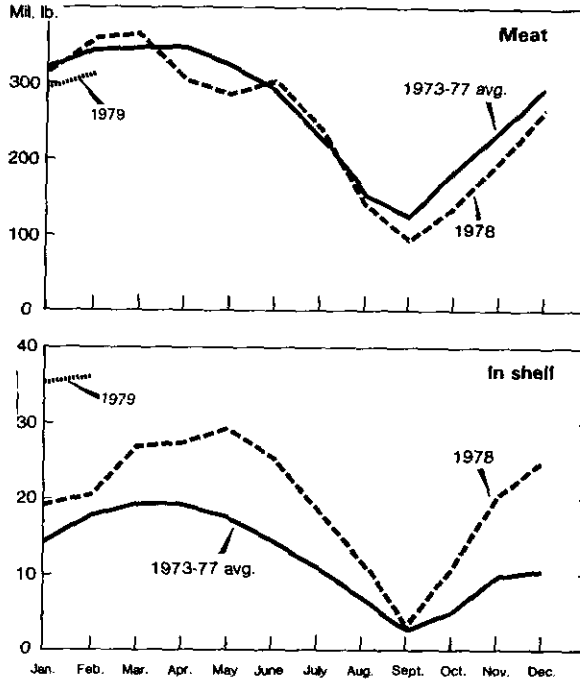
OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was 58 percent, unchanged from January 31. Freezer occupancy at 67 percent was off 2 points from last month, but 1 point above last year.
